- 3 % Schoolhouse Bonds, Series 1959, Receipt # A25067.



Dear Sir:

We received the papers for indefinite commitments this morning for the following named patients: Ima Jean Waters, Doyle E. Denton and Wiley Fred Youngblood, however, no money for the court cost was included with them. Our County has a court cost of \$50.63 which takes care of the expense involved for these hearings and this court cost is paid to the Kaufman County Clerk. Please advise us immediately who will be responsible for this court cost for these patients, and we will not be able to file these papers for hearings until we hear from you.

Also, on February 28, 1964 we wrote you concerning the court cost for Hulene Moore, but to date we have not received any word from you. We are still holding the papers on her.

We would appreciate hearing from you at an early date regarding the information requested.

When mailing us the papers for indefinite commitments, the only papers we need are five (5) copies of the Petition, and three (3) copies of the Waiver of Trial by Jury.
