TAKE NOTICE that an election will be held on the 11th

 NO. 42 OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS, to determine whether said Common  
 School District shall be converted to an Independent School District  
 for school purposes, to be known as UNION GROVE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL  
 DISTRICT of Upshur County, Texas, in obedience to an ELECTION ORDER  
 made and entered by the County Judge of Upshur County upon the  
 Minutes of the Commissioners' Court, granting the petition for said  
 election, which said order is dated the 11th day of ~~October~~<sup>November</sup>, 1965,  
 and such order reads and provides as follows:

## ELECTION ORDER

WHEREAS, on the 11th day of ~~October~~<sup>November</sup>, 1965, a petition was presented to me by Jeff Johnson and 41 other persons of the UNION GROVE COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 42 OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS, asking that an election be ordered to be held within the said District for the purpose of determining whether or not the said Common School District shall be converted to an Independent School District for School purposes, and to be known as UNION GROVE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT; and

IT APPEARING that said petition is signed by more than twenty (20) legally qualified property taxpaying voters residing within the present boundaries of UNION GROVE COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 42 OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS, and that said petition is in every respect in conformity with law; and

IT FURTHER APPEARING that said UNION GROVE COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 42 OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS, maintains a first-class high school of twelve grades, offering sixteen or more credits, and that said District has been heretofore legally established and has been recognized in its present form by all State and County authorities as a legally existing school district,

THEREFORE, I, L. G. McKinley, in my official capacity as County Judge of Upshur County, Texas, DO HEREBY FIND AND DETERMINE the sufficiency of such petition and that the facts presented to me in support of such petition are true and substantially conclusive and, in consequence thereof, I DO HEREBY ORDER that an election be held on the 11th day of ~~NOVEMBER~~<sup>NOVEMBER</sup>, 1965, which date is not less than twenty (20) nor more than thirty (30) days from the date the aforesaid petition was filed, as aforesaid, for the purpose of determining whether the UNION GROVE COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 42 OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS, shall be converted to an Independent School District for school purposes, and to be known as UNION GROVE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT of Upshur County, Texas, under authority conferred by Article 2742j of the Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, 1925, as amended.

THAT said election shall be held at Union Grove and in the UNION GROVE COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 42 OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS, and the officers of said election shall be as follows:

Lloyd, is hereby appointed as Clerk for ABSENTEE VOTING at the election herein ordered and absentee voting shall be conducted at County Clerks Office, Gilmer, Texas, and said Clerk shall keep the office open between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. each day that is not a Saturday, a Sunday, or an official State holiday, all in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 424, Acts of the 58th Legislature, Regular Session, 1963.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the ballots for said election shall be prepared in sufficient number and in conformity with Chapter 8, V.A.T.C.S. Election Code, as amended, and that printed on such ballots shall appear the following proposition:

"FOR CONVERSION"

"AGAINST CONVERSION"

ONLY qualified voters who are residents of the UNION GROVE COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 42 OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS, shall be entitled to vote at said election.

THAT SAID election shall be held under the provisions of the laws of this State regulating general elections except as otherwise provided by the statute hereinabove referred to.

NOTICE of this election shall be given by posting a substantial copy of this order at three different public places within said District, and the officers holding the said election shall make returns of the result thereof within five days after said election has been held.


