
Enclosed herewith please find two copies of County Court Permit for the water lines and for the sewer lines for the above referenced water supply corporation.

TO: Pine Acres Water Supply Corporation,
a Texas Corporation

The Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, has no objection to the location on the right-of-way of your proposed sewer line as shown by accompanying drawings and to be owned by a non-profit organization.

It is expressly understood that the Upshur County Commissioners Court does not purport, hereby, to grant any right, claim, title, or easement in or upon this county road, and it is further understood that in the future should for any reason Upshur County need to work, improve, relocate, widen, increase, add to, or in any manner change the structure of this right-of-way, this line, if affected will be moved under the direction of the Upshur County Commissioners Court or its duly authorized representative and shall be relocated at the complete expense of the owner.

All work on the County right-of-way shall be performed in accordance with County instructions. The installation shall not damage any part of the County Road and adequate provisions must be made to cause minimum inconvenience to traffic and adjacent property owners.

The herein named County will at no time be held liable for any damage to said sewer line while improving and maintaining County roads. It is agreed with County that this permit can be assigned to the Farmers Home Administration, an agency of the United States Government, for collateral monies received to construct said sewer lines
