
CHEVY 4-Door Nova Station Wagon

County, Texas, do hereby acknowledge that the Commissioners' Court of the said County has notified me to file suit for the collection of delinquent taxes in said county, however, due to the fact that it would be physically impossible for me to personally file and handle such suits, and at the same time to properly discharge the other duties of my office, and to the further fact that the statutes do not provide adequate compensation for a/^{Criminal District}~~County~~ Attorney to file and to prosecute suits for delinquent taxes, but do make adequate provisions for other attorneys to handle the same, I do hereby decline to file such suits and do hereby waive the thirty days written notice provided in Article 7335, Revised Civil Statutes, and do hereby agree that the Commissioners' Court of said County may contract with some other competent attorney to enforce or assist in the enforcement of the collection of delinquent State and County taxes.

ation the making of a contract for the collection of delinquent

County Commissioner of Precinct No. _____, that subject to
approval by the Comptroller of Public Accounts and Attorney
General of Texas said Commissioners' Court in behalf of said
County do make and enter into a contract with F. A. Hunter
_____, a licensed attorney, for the latter to collect
delinquent taxes in said County for 15 % of the amount of
Taxes, penalty and interest collected, said contract to end on
the 31 day of December, 1968, with six months

thereafter to complete pending suits, requiring said attorney to give bond in the sum of \$ 1,000.00, and to be on forms currently promulgated and recommended by the State Comptroller .


Said motion being put to vote, it carried by a vote of 4 to 0. Those voting "Aye" were:






