Minutes of Upshur County Commissioners Court

Motion made by Bryant Holmes, seconded by A. D. Hackler and approved by votes of 4 for and 0 against that the Upshur County Commissioners Court approves the transfer to the Gilmer Industrial Foundation of 13.66 acres of Land further described in this motion, by amending the Legislative Act of _____ in which Upshur County obtained title of the original tract of the former Sweet Potato Experiment Station from the State of Texas. The County ~~County~~ reserves all Minerals and convey surface rights only.

The Court takes notice that a public airfield has been built on approximately 32 acres of this original tract, adjoining the 13.66 acres to be described. This public use will be consistent with the original terms of County acquisition of this land. The 13.66 acre tract is in the northeast corner of the former Sweet Potato Experiment Station tract, more particularly described by attached field notes provided by County Surveyor E. McClelland.
