WHEREAS, the County of Upshur, State of Texas, desirous to provide for fees to be collected for said County for each license issued under the Texas Liquor Control Act:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS:

Upshur County, Texas, hereafter shall levy and collect from every person licensed as provided under the Texas Liquor Control Act, a fee on each license equal to one-half of the fee levied by the State of Texas for such license issued as provided for by Article 667-1(h) of the Penal Code of the State of Texas.

Nothing herein contained shall prevent the levying, assessing and collecting of general ad valorem taxes on the property of such licensee.

AN ORDER APPROVING CLAIM SUBMITTED BY
CONTRACTOR AND ATTORNEY IN CONNECTION WITH
CONTRACT WITH UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS, SUCH
CONTRACT BEING DATED MARCH 8, 1971.

WHEREAS, by order of this Court, passed and adopted on the 8th day of March, 1971, (the same being of record in the minutes of the Court), there were authorized to be issued \$30,000.00 "Upshur County, Texas, Road Improvement Warrants," dated June 15, 1971, it being provided that such warrants were to be executed and delivered by the County Judge, County Clerk, and County Treasurer, upon order of the Court on submitted claims (duly audited, approved and allowed by this Court prior to the delivery of said warrants) as the resurfacing has been completed, and

WHEREAS, the order authorizing the issuance of warrants, also approves the contract between M. G. Williams, contractor, Tyler, Texas, and the County of Upshur and provided that \$ 28,000.00 due by the County thereunder would be paid through the issuance and delivery of the above described warrants, and that the sum of \$ 790.00 would be paid in cash out of funds then appropriated and set aside for the purpose; and

WHEREAS, the contract (awarded only after compliance with the provisions of Article 2368a, V.A.T.C.S.) has been recognized as a valid obligation of Upshur County, and said contractor and attorney have submitted claim for payment for services and materials under said contract, and which claims have been duly audited by this Court, which claims are attached and become a part of these minutes; and

WHEREAS, it is now proper and advisable for this Commissioners Court to make provision for the payment of the amount due said contractor and attorney as shown in said claim, and that payment should be made through the issuance and delivery

of interest bearing time warrants out of the aforesaid authorization to M. G. Williams, contractor, and Welby K. Parish, attorney, in the aggregate sum of \$ 28000.00 being warrants numbered 1 through 28, bearing interest at the rate of five (5%) per cent per annum, in denominations of \$1,000.00 each, and being those warrants scheduled to mature on December 15, in accordance with the following schedule:

\$ 7000.00 in 1971

\$ 7000.00 in 1972

\$ 8000.00 in 1973

\$ 6000.00 in 1974

Therefore, be it ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas:

Section 1: That the claim of the contractor and attorney is hereby approved and allowed, it being judicially and affirmatively found and determined that same is proper and constitutes evidence of benefits duly received by Upshur County, Texas.

Section 2: That the County Judge, County Clerk and County Treasurer of this county are hereby directed to execute and deliver the warrants of this county to the said contractor and attorney.

Section 3: That the said warrants authorized to be executed and delivered are hereby found to be valid and subsisting obligations of Upshur County, Texas, and it is hereby expressly and affirmatively adjudged and decreed that the county has received full value and consideration therefor; that all things required by law in the issuance and delivery of said warrants have happened and have been performed in due time, form and manner as required by law; that all material furnished under said contract, insofar as said claim is concerned, have been

found to be in all respects as provided for in the said contract. This judicial ascertainment is expressly made for the use and benefit of the prospective owners and holders of said warrants, the Attorney General of Texas and any other attorney that may pass upon the validity of said warrants and the same shall be binding upon Upshur County, Texas, the Commissioners Court thereof, and the successors in office of the County Judge and members of the Commissioners Court of said county.

Section 4: That all acts of the aforesaid officials of the county regarding the execution and delivery of said warrants shall be prima facie evidence that such acts have been completed in all respects in the proper manner to give validity and legality to said warrants to cause them to create a good, sufficient and valid obligation upon Upshur County, Texas.

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


