ORGANIZATION OF BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

BE IT REMEMBERED that on this the 8 day of MAY 19 72, the Commissioners' Court of UPSHUR County, Texas, was duly convened as a Board of Equalization, at the regular meeting place at the Court House in the town of GILMER. That upon convening of said Board, and prior to entering upon their duties as a Board of Equalization, each of the above named members took and subscribed to the following oath:

"I, L. M. McQuinn ^{County Judge} ~~County Commissioner~~, a member of the Board of Equalization of UPSHUR County, Texas, for the year A.D., 1972, hereby solemnly swear:

"That in the performance of my duties as a member of such Board for said year, I will not vote to allow any taxable property to stand assessed on the tax rolls of said County for said year at any sum which I believe to be less than its true market value, or if it has no market value, then its real value; that I will faithfully endeavor, and as a member will move to have each item of taxable property which I believe to be assessed for said year at less than its true market value, or real value, raised on the tax rolls to what I believe to be its true market value, if it has a market value, and if not, then to its real value, and that I will faithfully endeavor, to have the assessed valuation of all property subject to taxation within said County, stand upon the tax rolls of said County for said year at its true cash market value, or if it has no market value, then its real value, I solemnly swear that I have read and understand the provisions contained in the Constitution and Laws of this State relative to the valuation of taxable property, and that I will faithfully perform all of the duties required of me under the Constitution and Laws of this State. So Help Me God."

Gentlemen:

We have inspected your courthouse and find that it is in need of the following: Exterior Surface--cleaning, patching, two (2) coats of waterproofing, cutting out cracks and broken corners, etc, and patch with stone dust matching existing stone and replacing bad mortar. Re-doing of Windows--caulking, glazing, priming and painting and replacing broken glass. Roof Flashing--one (1) trowel on mastic, one (1) ply glass, and two (2) trowel on mastic. Exterior entrance ceiling to be cleaned and repainted. Re-set loose stones in monument. The price for steps would depend on owners requirements for necessary work to be done. Samples would have to be submitted to owners to see what system they want to use.
