 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT, the County of Upshur, acting by and through its Commissioners' Court, hereinafter called Grantor, does by these presents grant and demise unto FOUKE WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION of Quitman, Texas, hereinafter called Grantee, a right-of-way and easement to lay, construct, maintain, operate, repair and remove a water line in, upon and across certain road rights-of-way lying within the area of construction of a water supply system to be constructed by said Corporation according to plans and specifications presented by its engineers, it being understood by and between the parties hereto that this grant consists only of the right to use said premises for the purposes above stated; said easement to be on that county road closest to the county line between Upshur and Wood Counties, said county road beginning at the North right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 80 nearest to the Southwest corner of Upshur County and then proceeding in an approximate Northerly direction five thousand feet (5000 ft.), more or less, until said road intersects with an unnamed Upshur County county road running East and West, and that the following requirements and conditions are applicable as a part of the consideration for this grant:

1. All lines shall be laid at a depth of not less than thirty (30) inches below the surface of the bar ditch of said road or easement and no part of said line or attachment thereto shall protrude above the surface of the ground within said easement.

2. All crossings of such roadways or right-of-way must be made by boring under said road or right-of-way and not by surface excavation. Before making such bore, the Commissioner of the precinct involved shall be given sufficient notice of the time of beginning of such work as will enable him to inspect the same.

3. The Corporation will be responsible for all damages unnecessarily done to any part of said road and will repair the same at its own expense and shall not unnecessarily interfere with the use of said road during construction operations.

4. Grantor herein shall not be held liable for any claim, damages, cause of action or other obligation that may arise as a result of the construction of said line and in case of construction in the future of other roads, highways, or other structures by the County, State or other agency requiring adjustment, removal, relocation of said water line, the Corporation shall, at its own expense, adjust, remove or relocate the same.

5. Said Grantor shall not be held liable for any damage, claim or cause of action resulting from the maintenance of said road or roads to such lines.

6. This agreement may be assigned to Farmers Home Administration or any agency of the United States Government, as collateral for monies received for the construction of said water line.

7. Should other easements be acquired from adjoining owners before the laying of said lines upon said roads the easements will be used for such purposes to the use of such County roads.


