MINUTES PERTAINING TO PASSAGE OF AN ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS

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ON THIS, the 17th day of December, 1973, the Commissioners' Court of Upshur County, Texas, convened in SPECIAL session at the REGULAR meeting place thereof in the Courthouse at Gilmer, Texas, the meeting being open to the public and notice of said meeting, giving the date, place and subject thereof, having been posted as prescribed by Article 6252-17, Section 3A, V.A.T.C.S., there being present and in attendance the following members of the Court, to wit:

The County Judge submitted the following order to the Court:

"AN ORDER by the Commissioners' Court of Upshur County, Texas, providing for the issuance of notice to bidders of the intention of the County to receive bids for the purpose of furnishing all plant, labor, materials and equipment and the performing of all work required for remodeling and improving the Upshur County Courthouse, and of the County's intention to authorize the issuance and delivery of certificates of obligation in payment of all or a portion of the contractual obligation of the County to be incurred."

The order having been read in full, it was moved by Commissioner Cantrell Loyd and seconded by Commissioner Charles Still that the same be adopted. Thereupon, the question being called for, the following members of the Court voted "AYE": County Judge McKinley and Commissioners Nobles, Loyd, Still and McCurry; and none voted "NO".

The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed, and the Clerk was instructed to record same in the proper Minutes of the Court.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that there is a need for remodeling and improving the County Courthouse in Upshur County, Texas; and,

WHEREAS, this Commissioners' Court now deems it proper to provide for the issuance of notice to bidders of the County's intention to receive bids for the construction of remodeling and improving the Upshur County Courthouse and of the County's intention to issue certificates of obligation to pay all or a portion of the contract price; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the County Judge is hereby authorized and directed to cause to be issued and published a notice to bidders of the County's intention to receive construction bids for the purpose of furnishing all plant, labor, materials and equipment and the performing of all work required for remodeling and improving the Upshur County Courthouse, and of the County's intention to issue certificates of obligation in payment of all or a portion of the contract price and the contractual obligation it will incur.

SECTION 2: That the form and content of the notice, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof for all purposes is hereby approved; and said notice shall be published once a week for two consecutive weeks prior to the time set for letting the contract, the date of the first publication to be at least fourteen (14) full days prior to the date set for the receipt of bids.


SECTION 3: That the plans, specifications, form of contract documents and minimum wage rates relating to the remodeling and improving of said County Courthouse have been received, found to be satisfactory and are hereby approved.

NOTICE TO BIDDERS OF COUNTY'S INTENTION TO LET
CONTRACT FOR REMODELING AND IMPROVING THE UPSHUR
COUNTY COURTHOUSE

SEALED PROPOSALS addressed to HONORABLE L. G. MCKINLEY, County Judge, Upshur County, Texas, will be received at the County Courthouse, Gilmer, Texas, until 10:00 o'clock A.M. on the LAND day of January, 1974, for the purpose of furnishing all plant, labor, materials and equipment and the performing of all work required for remodeling and improving the Upshur County Courthouse, at which time and place the proposals will be publicly opened, read aloud and referred to the County Judge for consideration, checking and evaluation. Final award of the contract and issuance of certificates of obligation are proposed to be made on the 11 day of FEBRUARY, 1974, by the Commissioners' Court convened in regular session at its regular meeting place at the County Courthouse.

BIDS shall be submitted in sealed envelopes upon the blank form of proposal furnished. Sealed envelopes shall be marked "BID FOR UPSHUR COUNTY COURTHOUSE."

PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS and contract documents may be examined without charge at the office of the County Clerk, Upshur County Courthouse, Gilmer, Texas. Copies of such instruments may be obtained from the office of LELAND A. GUINN, Architect, P. O. Box 149, Longview, Texas 75601 upon a payment of \$ 52.00 per set. Any unsuccessful bidder will be refunded his payment and any non-bidder will be refunded \$ 52.00 upon returning such set promptly and in good condition.

A CASHIER'S CHECK, certified check or acceptable bidder's bond made payable to the order of the County Judge, Upshur County, Texas, in an amount of five percent (5%) of the bid submitted must accompany each bid as a guarantee that if awarded the contract, the bidder will promptly enter into a contract with the County and execute such bonds as are required. Bids without the required check or bid bond will not be considered.

THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER on the project will be required to furnish a performance bond and payment bond, each in the full amount of the contract, written by a responsible surety company authorized to do business in the State of Texas, and satisfactory to the Commissioners' Court as required by Article 5160, V.A.T.C.S. Attention of bidders is also directed to the provisions of Article 5159a, V.A.T.C.S., requiring that not less than the general prevailing rates of per diem wages for work of similar character in the locality where the work is performed shall be paid all laborers, workmen and mechanics employed in the construction of public works.


BIDDERS are expected to inspect the site of the work and to inform themselves of all local conditions, and carefully examine the plans, specifications and other documents. Should a bidder find discrepancies in, or omissions from the plans, specifications or other documents, or should he question their meaning, he should at once notify the Architect in writing seven (7) days prior to submitting any bid, and obtain clarification.

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NO BIDDER may withdraw his bid for at least thirty (30) days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids.

On the date and time set for the awarding of the contract (FEBRUARY 11, 1974, 10:00 o'clock M.) the County proposes to authorize the issuance of Certificates of Obligation (payable from taxation) in the maximum principal amount of \$400,000.00 in payment of all or a portion of the contract price and the contractual obligation it will incur. The successful bidder will be required to accept such certificates in payment of all or a portion of the contract price or assign such certificates to the party with whom the County has made provision for the contractor to sell and assign such certificates at their face value (no accrued interest), and each bidder shall be required to elect on the bid form whether he will accept or assign such certificates.

In case of ambiguity or lack of clarity in stating the contract price, the County reserves the right to consider the most advantageous construction thereof or to reject the bid and to waive formalities.
