UPSHUR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT

GILMER, TEXAS

June 16, 1975

The Commissioners Court was called to order at a special meeting June 16, 1975, by Judge Everett Dean with all members present.

An application for a right of way water permit from Roland Lambert was signed. The application had been approved at an earlier meeting.

A right of way permit from East Texas Telephone Coop., Inc. was presented. A motion was made by J. D. Meadows and seconded by Offie Nobles to accept. The motion carried, and the permit was signed.

John Salters and Richard Howell, representatives of Continental Telephone Company of Texas, presented 4 right of way permits to the Court. These permits were for underground cables. A discussion was held, and Charles Still objected to one of the permits stating that it could do damage to the construction of the highway or road that the cable was crossing. Charles Still made a motion which was seconded by J. W. Meadows that 3 of these permits be approved and that a further investigation be made on the fourth and approve it at a later date (These applications are attached.).

Wayne Wilson and Jessie Bustin, representing the Civil Defense Unit of this district, reported that they had probably found a new generator costing approximately \$160 at the Army Surplus Store. They explained that it is a 15 - 20 thousand unit, and it would be sufficient to operate power for all of the Courthouse. The only other emergency unit in the county is operated by the Gilmer Fire Department which is not enough if an emergency should arise. Bruce Morris had informed the Judge earlier that there is enough money in the budget to purchase this new generator. Mr. Bustin agreed that he would take care of the equipment by keeping it in working condition at all times. Floyd Drennan made motion and Charles Still seconded that up to \$300 be granted to Civil Defense to purchase the necessary equipment for this unit. A vote was taken, and the motion carried.

Judge Dean stated that the District Clerk had asked for a new top be put on the counter in that office. The cost of this would be approximately \$306. No action was taken.

The selling of the air conditioners which had been removed from the windows of the Courthouse during remodeling was discussed. An offer of \$50 across the counter for each unit had been made. There was a discussion on this offer. Judge Dean announced that there are 16 units and that an ad would be put in the Gilmer Mirror asking for bids with July 4, 1975, being the last date to receive bids.

A discussion for a new overhead power line from SWEPCO was heard. The line is from Cason-Hawkins to the Perdue Station. No action was taken on this matter.

Offie Nobles made the motion which was seconded by J. W. Meadows to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried. Meeting was adjourned.
