The Commissioners Court of Upshur County met in regular session. The Court ordered a Special Election be held in Upshur County November 4, 1975 in compliance with Proclamation issued by Governor Dolph Briscoe. Election will be held at all regular Precinct Polling places. Hours will be from 7 a.m. to 7 p. m. Rate of pay for election Judges and Clerks will be \$25.00 for election judge and \$20.00 for election clerks.

Commissioners Court of Upshur County met in regular session with all members present: Offie Nobles, J. W. Meadows, Charles Still, Floyd Drennan and Everett Dean. Judge Dean presided.

Mrs. Elizabeth Barnett representing Republic Title Agency of Longview, Texas met with the Court asking permission to buy records being filed with Upshur County Clerk's Office which are Microfilmed by Business Records Corporation for Upshur County. She made an offer of \$150.00 per month to Upshur County for these records. They will also pay Business Records a fee. Charles Still made a motion to accept the offer for 12 months and a second was made by Judge Everett Dean. Motion carried. This contract will expire September 1, 1976. This fee is to be paid to the County Clerk's Office as recording fees.

A Permit Application was presented from Western Gas Corporation asking permission to cross a County road that is near Enon and Rosewood. A motion was made to accept this permit by Floyd Drennan and seconded by J. W. Meadows. Motion carried. (Permit is attached)

A Permit Application was presented from the City of Gladewater asking for a Sewer line to cross Pyett Drive in Upshur County. A motion to accept this application was made by Offie Nobles and was seconded by Charles Still. Motion carried. (Permit is attached)

Judge Dean made a report from Mr. Ashbrook asking for an expense account of \$15.00 per month for travel. J. W. Meadows made a motion for Mr. Ashbrook to receive this amount and a second was made by Offie Nobles. Motion carried.

Offie Nobles made motion and was seconded by J. W. Meadows that the County Clerk advise Election Judges as to the number of workers to be used in each box for the November 4, 1975 Special Election.

A letter was read by Judge Dean from Mr. Gorman Cosson asking about Sub-Stations for auto registrations. Bill Jones also met with the Court to ask about the Sub-Stations. He reported that there are five stations in Upshur County and asked that the stations be continued. J. W. Meadows made a motion and was seconded by Floyd Drennan to table this until the next ^{regular} Court meeting. Motion Carried.

The bids were opened for 2½ ton truck for Precinct #2. A bid from Long Motor Company, Incorporated was accepted. (Bid attached)

Wayne Wilson met with the Court to give a report on the new generator which has been brought for the Civil Defense Unit. He reported that it has been tested and they are ready to serve the people in Upshur County where they are needed with this equipment.

Offie Nobles made a motion and a second was made by Floyd Drennan that the bill be paid. Motion carried.

J. W. Meadows made a motion to adjourn and was seconded by Offie Nobles. Motion carried. Court Adjourned.



U.S. 271 TO GILMER





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
