Floyd Drennan made a motion to accept and was seconded by J. W. Meadows to accept this proposal. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Floyd Drennan to approve bills and was seconded by Charles Still. Motion carried.

Offie Nobles made a motion to adjourn and was seconded by J. W. Meadows. Motion carried. Meeting Adjourned.


