Rogers, Mrs. Frankie Lindley and Willie Thompson. They presented a proposal stating that the cost of the landscaping would be at least \$3,000.00. No action was taken on this matter. Judge Dean asked that the committee be present at the meeting of the Court on December 8, 1975 and bring with them bids for this work.

A Permit Application from W. M. Ballard was presented asking for permission to cross Evergreen road with a waterline in precinct #1. Offie Nobles made a motion to accept this permit and a second was made by J. W. Meadows. Motion carried. (Copy of application attached.)

A report was made that two men had made application asking to be appointed to serve as Constable at Rosewood to replace Mr. John Worthington. Charles Still stated that he thought that anyone wishing to be appointed to this job should meet with the Court in person. No action was taken on this matter.

J. W. Meadows made motion for Court to adjourn and a second was made by Floyd Drennan. Motion carried. Court adjourned.
