

December 8, 1975

The Commissioners Court met in regular session with all members present: Offie Nobles, J. W. Meadows Charles Still, Floyd Drennan and Judge Everett Dean. Judge Dean Presided.

Those present for the meeting were. Mrs. John Worthington, Phillip Williams with the Gilmer Radio Station. Mr. R. A. Morris of Ore City Texas, Mrs Sarah Greene with the Gilmer Mirror, Bybee Weisinger with the Texas Highway Department and Mrs Frankie Lindley who is on the Landscaping Committie for the County Court Yard.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by Judge Dean. After the minutes were approved, Judge Dean made a motion to accept the minutes as read and a second was made by J. W. Meadows. Motion carried.

A Letter was read by Judge Dean from Jo Etta York making an announcement to the Court that Mr. John Henry was resigning his postion as Upshur County Extension Agent. He will assume the position of Area Resource Development Specialist for the Extension Service in District 10 and 11 headquartered at College Station, Texas March 1, 1976. Judge Dean made motion to accept his resignation and was seconded by Floyd Drennan. Motion carried.

A Permit Application from M. J. Delaney Drilling Company was presented asking to put a 2" temporary waterline approximately 1/2 mile along Almond Road from White Oak Creek in a North East direction. Charles Still made a motion to accept this application and was seconded by Floyd Drennan. Motion carried. (copy of permit attached)

A Permit Application from Mrs Carl Minshew was presented asking permission to place a water-line within the Right-of-Way of County Road Sumac Lane in the Willow Oak Community. J. W. Meadows made a motion to accept this application and a second was made by Floyd Drennan. Motion carried (a copy of Permit is attached.)

Mrs. John Worthington was introduced by Judge Dean. She made a Speach asking to be appointed a finish serving the term as Constable of her late husband, John Worthington. A motion was made by Floyd Drennan to appoint Mrs Worthington to finish serving the term and was seconded by J. W. Meadows. Motion Carried

Bybee Weisinger, representing the State Highway Department reported the County would be responsible for getting the Right-of-Ways, repairing and replacing fences on a proposed farm Market Road at Rhonsboro and Grice which is to be 1.8 miles in length. It was announced that it would take about one year for the County to obtain these Right-of-Ways. No Action was taken on this.

R. A. Morris asked that the road be widened: - Camp Joy Sub-Division. There was some discussion but no action was taken.

Offie Nobles made motion and was seconded by J. W. Meadows to pay bills, Motion carried.

J. W. Meadows mademotion to adjourn and seconded by Floyd Drennan. Motion carried. Metting adjourned.


