Judge Dean asked if anyone had any suggestions for the improvements of the Courthouse lawn. No action was taken on this.

J. W. Meadows made a motion to approve the bills for payment and was seconded by Floyd Drennan. Motion carried.

Charles Still made a motion for the Court to adjourn and was seconded by J. W. Meadows. Motion carried. Court Adjourned.



