SPECIAL EMERGENCY MEETING OF COMMISSIONERS COURT RELATIVE TO RABIES EPIDEMIC.

Whereas: Public hearing was held on May 3, 1976 concerning a rabies epidemic in Upshur County and the determination was made that an emergency does exist.

Whereas: To protect the people of Upshur County from the dangers of a rabies epidemic, the Commissioners Court of Upshur County does issue the following resolution.

BE IT RESOLVED that all owners of dogs, cats, and other pet animals susceptible to rabies be encouraged to protect said animals by vaccination of said animals.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the population be notified of this emergency situation by the publication of this resolution in all newspapers circulated in the county and the newscasting from radio stations in the county.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a vaccination clinic be sponsored in each community, especially where one has not been held.
