The Commissioners Court met in special session with all members of the court present: Offie Nobles, J. W. Meadows, Charles Still, Floyd Drennan and Judge Everett Dean. Judge Dean presided.

Mrs David Woods, Mrs. Henry Morgan, Mrs. Francine Jackson, Mrs. Dorothy Gilbraith, Lawrence C. Gilbraith, Jr. and Mr. Jack Dunagan, a group from the Rocky Community met to discuss and find out about the Gladewater Fire Department and their answering calls in Upshur County. Judge Dean explained that the Court had approved to pay the Gladewater Fire Department the sum of \$50.00 per month for fire prevention in their Upshur County Area. This \$50.00 check was returned to Judge Dean which they would not accept. The group said that they would meet with Gladewater City Council to discuss this.

A motion was made by Offie Nobles and seconded by J. W. Meadows to approve a permit application from Arkansas Louisiana Gas Company to cross and parallel Bluebird Lane also to cross Bobolink Trail with a 2" Gas main line. Motion carried. (Copy attached.)

A motion was made by Charles Still and seconded by J. W. Meadows to approve a permit application from David M. Gilbraith to place a driveway culvert on old highway 80 right-of-way. Motion carried. (Copy attached.)

A motion was made by Offie Nobles and seconded by J. W. Meadows to approve a permit application from William Light to place a driveway culvert on the right-of-way of Evergreen Road. Motion Carried. (Copy attached.)

A motion was made by J. W. Meadows, seconded by Offie Nobles to approve the unpaid bills, Motion carried.

County Clerk J. B. Hill asked the courts permission to hire Mrs. Patria Owens as deputy clerk. Motion was made by Judge Dean to approve this, seconded by Floyd Drennan. Motion carried.

Judge Dean read the minutes of the courts July 8, 1976 meeting. Motion was made by J.W. Meadows to approve these minutes as read. Seconded by Charles Still. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Floyd Drennan to adjourn. It was seconded by J. W. Meadows.. Motion carried.


