Commissioners Court met in special session with all members present; Floyd Drennan, Charles Still, J.W. Meadows, Offie Nobles, and Judge Everett Dean. Judge Dean presided.

County Auditor, Bruce Morris, met with the court to discuss the Probation System. Mr. Morris said the probation system now serves Camp, Marion, Upshur, and Wood counties. This program was set up for four years. It has been his duties to handle the money, and that since the grant money has run out, each county is suppose to pay its pro rata share to support it. As some of the counties would not pay their share as they should on time, the probation fund has been overdrawn twice. Mr. Morris said also, as far as he was concerned he was about ready for some of the other counties to do the work and worrying.

J.W. Meadows asked the question of getting a grant for a one county system. Mr. Morris said that it was a possibility. Offie Nobles suggested that Mr. Morris look into Upshur County getting a grant.

Mrs. Arnold Gage met with the court asking about a road at New Hope Community, that John D. Reeves had closed by fencing it. She wanted to know if he had received permission from the county court to do so. No one knew. No action was taken.

Judge Dean was called to District Court. As he was called, J.W. Meadows made a motion for Commissioners Court to adjourn until July 26, 1976. It was seconded by Offie Nobles. Motion carried.
