**UPSHUR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT**

September 2, 1976

Commissioners Court met in special session with all members present. Offie Nobles, J.W. Meadows, Charles Still, Floyd Drennan, and Judge Everett Dean. Judge Dean presided.

County Auditor, Bruce Morris met with the court to present and explain the budget for Upshur County for the coming year 1977. Offie Nobles made a mbtion to accept the budget as read. It was seconded by J.W. Meadows. Motion carried.

The minutes of the August 30, 1976 meeting was read by Judge Dean. Floyd Drennan made a motion the minutes stand as read. Seconded by Charles Still. Motion carried.

A permit application from James H. Goddard Jr. for a drive-way culvert to be placed on county right-of-way of county road Pleasant Trail was presented to the court to be approved. Offie Nobles made a motion to approve this application. Seconded by J.W. Meadows. Motion carried. (copy attached).

A permit application from General Telephone Company to place a buried telephone cable within the right-of-way of county road North Point Pleasant Road was presented to the court. Offie Nobles made a motion to approve this application. It was seconded by J.W. Meadows. Motion carried. (Copy attached).

Judge Dean explained to the court that the closed circuit T.V. for the County Jail would either have to be installed or have to be returned. The Court asked Judge Dean to find out what the cost would be to have this installed.

The Gilmer City Mayor, Harry Lucas, City Manager James Dover, and councilmen Buddy Arnold, David Skinner, Ralph Byman, and Larry Bedard, met with the court asking for help from the county for the dump ground. They asked the county if they could buy some land to be used for dump ground purposes, in exchange for rural fire protection from the city. No action was taken on this, but the court agreed to give the city an answer next meeting day. September 13, 1976.

Charles Still made a motion to pay all workers for the General Election the \$2.20 per hour, with additional \$5.00 for Election Judges. Floyd Drennan seconded. Motion carried.

Judge Dean asked the court what they were going to do about the City of Gladewater and the Lake Gladewater road, in exchange for the rural fire protection. No action was taken on this.

Floyd Drennan made a motion to approve the unpaid bills.
It was seconded by J.W. Meadows. Motion carried.

Judge Dean asked that the court discontinue until Sept. 10, 1976.





