Floyd Drennan made a motion, seconded by Charles Still, to approve (3) permit applications from Charles Swanner to place driveway culverts on the right of way of Jaguar Road. Motion carried. (copies of these applications attached)

Charles Still made a motion, seconded by Floyd Drennan, to approve a special road permit of Western Gas Corporation for use of county roads in Upshur County, Precinct #3. Motion carried. (copies of application, contract and map attached)

Judge Dean read a letter from child welfare and asked the court to select four people to serve on the Upshur County Child Welfare Board. J.W. 



WHEREAS, the office of the County Auditor of Upshur County, Texas, has heretofore been established in conformity with law, and is now vacant, and it now becomes the duty of the District Judge having jurisdiction in Upshur County, Texas, to fill such vacancy by appointing a County Auditor;

Now, Therefore, I, Virgil E. Mulanax, Judge, 115th Judicial District Court, the Court having jurisdiction in Upshur County, Texas, do hereby appoint Bobbie Evelyn Hankins, a qualified person and citizen of Upshur County, Texas, as Acting County Auditor of Upshur County, Texas; and she shall, before entering upon the duties of said office, take and subscribe the oaths prescribed by law, as set forth in Article 1649, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, and enter into bond as therein provided, payable and conditioned as prescribed by law, and upon qualifying, shall hold said office and discharge the duties thereof for a period not to exceed two years from the date she shall qualify under this appointment or until her successor shall be duly appointed and qualified.

The salary of Six Hundred Dollars per month shall be paid in monthly installments at the end of each calendar month, as provided by law, and the said Bobbie Evelyn Hankins shall perform the duties prescribed for the office of the County Auditor and be subject to the provisions of law respecting her duties.

This order shall be entered in the minutes of the 115th District Court of Upshur County, Texas, and be certified by the Clerk of said Court to the Commissioners' Court of Upshur County, Texas, which shall cause the same to be entered in the minutes with appropriate order directing payment of the salary.

The Commissioners Court of Upshur County met in regular session with all members present. The following resolution was adopted by this court.

Be it resolved that a bell belonging to the C. H. Roberts Estate, located on the north side of the Gilmer town square is recognized as a historical relic of Upshur County and Gilmer, Texas. It is therefore further resolved that said court be allowed to place this bell on the courthouse lawn with appropriate concrete footing and fencing to preserve said bell for residents and visitors of Upshur County. It is requested that a proper plaque with history of said bell and name of donor be placed as a marker at site of bell by County Historical Survey Committee.
