

**UPSHUR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT**

GILMER, TEXAS

Upshur County Commissioners Court met in special session on October 25, 1976 with all members present. Judge Dean presided.

Judge Dean read the court minutes of the October 11 meeting. A motion was made by Floyd Drennan, seconded by J.W. Meadows, to let the minutes stand approved as read. Motion carried.

Tax Assessor-Collector, W.C. "Bill" Jones, met with the court and asked that a resolution be passed for the \$3,000 tax exemption for persons 65 years of age and older for the year 1977. Floyd Drennan made a motion to approve this exemption, seconded by J.W. Meadows. Motion carried.

District Clerk Leo Williams asked the court to make a ruling that the books carried out of the Law Library be signed for when they are carried out. Floyd Drennan made a motion, seconded by J.W. Meadows, that signs be placed in the Law Library asking those persons checking out books to sign a card in the District Clerk's Office. Motion carried.

Harry Heard, District Attorney Elect, met with the court and presented a resolution which he asked the court to approve. This resolution authorized an application for a grant to the Criminal Justice Council to continue funding for an Assistant District Attorney. Floyd Drennan made a motion, seconded by J.W. Meadows, that this resolution be approved and adopted. Motion carried. (copy of resolution attached)

Charles Still made a motion, seconded by Offie Nobles, to approve a Special Road Use Agreement Contract for Louisiana Pacific Corp. while removing timber in Prec. #3. Motion carried. (copy of contract attached)

Floyd Drennan made a motion, seconded by J.W. Meadows, to approve permit application from Dan Patterson to place a culvert on right of way on Cherokee Trace. Motion carried. (copy of permit application attached)

Floyd Drennan made a motion, seconded by Charles Still, to approve permit application from A.D. Goodwin to place a driveway culvert on right of way of Giraffe Road. Motion carried. (copy of permit application attached)

Charles Still made a motion, seconded by Floyd Drennan, to approve permit application from Southwestern Electric Power Company to place a transmission line across the ROW of county roads in Prec. #3 as designated by map attached to application. Motion carried. (copy of permit application attached)

COUNTY OF UPSHUR | KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

The undersigned, Luisana Pacific Corp.
hereinafter referred to as First Party, enters into and makes
an agreement with Upshur County Commissioner of Precinct No. 3,
Upshur County, Texas, and in order to get material to market
it is necessary to use a portion of Upshur County roads located
in Precinct No. 3, over which Commissioner has jurisdiction
and obligation to maintain in good repair and both parties
being aware of possible damage to said roads as a result of
hauling on and over same enter into the following agreement.

1.

First Party agrees to use only that section of

First Party agrees to use its vehicles in such a
manner as not to block or interfere with other traffic on said
road so that said road will be open to travel by the public
at all times.

First Party agrees to grade, maintain and otherwise
repair said road using its own equipment, labor and materials,
if any needed, during the duration of time that First Party
is removing Timber from its lands located
in Precinct No. 3, Upshur County.

First Party agrees to put said road back into the
same condition as it was prior to the commencement of hauling
operations on the part of First Party.

First Party agrees to post surety bond in the amount of to Upshur County Commissioners Court to insure performance of agreement.

Nothing herein shall be construed as a waiver by the Commissioner of the authority granted him by Article 6716, V.A.C.S., but the rights and authority granted the Commissioner by the terms of Article 6716, V.A.C.S. are expressly reserved by the Commissioner in the event First Party fails to abide by the conditions above set forth.
