Formal notice is hereby given that GENERAL TELEPHONE COMPANY of the SOUTHWEST proposes to place a buried communication line within the right-of-way of a County Road in Upshur County, Texas as follows:

The proposed cable is to begin at Camp Natowa on an oil county road.

The proposed cable will be buried, with a road bore to the East side of right-of-way, and head Northeast for approximately 964 feet on the South side of right-of-way.

Cable will be buried a minimum of twenty-four inches in depth and within five feet of right-of-way.
