



UPSHUR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT

GILMER, TEXAS

January 17, 1977

Commissioners Court met in special session with all members present. Offie Nobles, J.W. Meadows, Charles Still, Floyd Drennan, and Judge Everett Dean. Judge Dean presided.

Bob Parsons met with the court to propose a hospital insurance plan for the county employees. No action was taken.

Hollie McClain met with the court, asking the court about buying the records of Upshur County from Business Records Corporation. No action was taken on this at this date.

Judge Dean read the minutes of the January 10, 1977 meeting. Motion was made by J.W. Meadows, seconded by Floyd Drennan for the minutes to stand approve as read. Motion carried.

Motion was made by J.W. Meadows, seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve the appointment of Keith Barber as County Auditor by District Judge Virgil Mulanax and the order to be placed in the court minutes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Charles Still, seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve a permit application for a drive-way culvert on Locust road for David Woods. Motion carried. (Copy attached).

Motion was made by Floyd Drennan, seconded by Charles Still to pass a resolution on load limits to certain county roads. Limit will be 21,000 pounds without a special road use permit on Hare, Ground Hogg, Jaguar, Giraff, and Stag. Motion carried. (Copy of this Resolution attached).

Don Hightower met with the court to give a report of the work that the juvenile probation officers have done in Upshur County for the last year.

Judge Dean read a letter on a meeting on Revenue Sharing to be held in Dallas on January 19, 1977. Judge Dean and County Auditor Keith Barber agreed to attend.

Motion was made by J.W. Meadows, seconded by Floyd Drennan that the group insurance plan made by Woodrow Roark, with the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company be accepted for the Employees of Upshur County. Motion carried.

J. W. Meadows made a motion, seconded by Offie Nobles to approve the unpaid bills. Motion carried.

Motion was made by J. W. Meadows, seconded by Charles Still that Mrs Bobbie Hankins be paid as chief deputy clerk. Motion carried.

COUNTY OF UPSHUR

Whereas, the office of the County Auditor for Upshur County, Texas, has heretofore been established in conformity with law, and is now vacant, and it now becomes the duty of the District Judge having jurisdiction in Upshur County, Texas, to fill such vacancy by appointing a County Auditor; and

Whereas, the compensation of the County Auditor for Upshur County, Texas, has heretofore been set at an amount not less than that paid the County Tax Assessor-Collector per year and has been approved by the Commissioners' Court for that amount;

Now, Therefore, I, Virgil Mulanax, Judge, 115th Judicial District Court, the Court having jurisdiction in Upshur County, Texas do hereby appoint Keith Barber, a qualified person and citizen of Upshur County, Texas, as County Auditor of Upshur County, Texas; and he shall, before entering upon the duties of said office, take and subscribe the oaths prescribed by law, as set forth in Article 1649, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, and enter into bond as therein provided, payable and conditioned as prescribed by law, and upon qualifying, shall hold said office and discharge the duties thereof for a period of two years from the date he shall qualify under this appointment and until his successor shall be duly appointed and qualified.

The salary herein provided shall be paid in equal monthly installments at the end of each calendar month, as provided by law, and the said Keith Barber, shall perform the duties prescribed for the office of the County Auditor and be subject to the provisions of law respecting his duties and tenure of office.

This order shall be entered in the minutes of the 115th District Court of Upshur County, Texas, and be certified by the Clerk of said Court to the Commissioners' Court of Upshur County, Texas, which shall cause the same to be entered in the minutes with appropriate order directing payment of the salary.

The following Resolution was introduced and Passed by Commissioners Court, Upshur County on January 17, 1977.

Whereas the following roads, Hare, Ground Hog, Jaguar, Giraff, and Stag, located in Upshur County, Texas being of such construction that loads of above 21,000 pounds will damage said roads. Therefore the Court places a maximum load limit of 21,000 pounds on said roads. Any party wishing to use said roads with loads in excess of these limits may do so with the use of Upshur County Special Road Use Permit, and the permission of the precinct County Road Commissioner.
