March 21, 1977

Commissioners Court met in regular session with Floyd Drennan, J. W. Meadows, Charles Still and Judge Everett Dean present.

Judge Dean read the minutes of the March 14, 1977 meeting. J. W. Meadows made a motion that the minutes stand approved as read. Floyd Drennan seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Charles Still, seconded by Floyd Drennan, to approve a permit application from Pritchett Water Supply to place a water line within the ROW of Pin Oak Road, to tie in at the flush valve at Smith's and cross the road with a 1 1/2" line to Robertson's. Motion carried. (Copy attached)

A motion was made by Floyd Drennan, seconded by J. W. Meadows, to accept a special road use agreement contract with Western Gas Corporation, permitting the drilling company to have access to roads in Precinct #4. (Copy attached)

A motion was made by Floyd Drennan, seconded by Charles Still, to approve a permit application from Western Gas Corporation for right-of-ways on Upshur County roads, the vicinity to be the same as agreed on in the Special Road Use Agreement. Motion carried. (Copy attached)

Judge Everett Dean read a resolution having to do with House Bills No. 1535, 1536, and 1537. A motion was made by Charles Still, seconded by Floyd Drennan, to accept and adopt said resolution. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Charles Still, seconded by J. W. Meadows, to not accept either of the bids submitted for the sale of the 1969 Ford dump truck of Precinct No. 3. Motion carried.

Judge Dean asked for a report on bids for typewriters. County Auditor, Keith Barber, reported that no action had been taken as yet.

A motion was made by Floyd Drennan, seconded by Charles Still, that any and all federal and state job-related programs will be first taken to the County Auditor, then to the Commissioners Court for placement of personnel employed under such programs. A motion was made by Charles Still, seconded by Floyd Drennan, to invite Mrs. Virginia Jones, Coordinator for the VOE Program, to the next regular meeting of the Commissioners Court. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Charles Still, seconded by Floyd Drennan, to postpone any action concerning the purchase of a new car for the Sheriff's Department. Motion carried.

Judge Dean made a motion to increase Burnice Ashbrook's expense account ten dollars a month. Charles Still seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Charles Still made a motion, seconded by Floyd Drennan, to approve the unpaid bills. Motion carried.

Floyd Drennan made a motion, seconded by Charles Still, to adjourn. Motion carried.

WHEREAS, The property tax is becoming an ever increasing burden on all property owners.


WHEREAS, Many additional state laws have been passed and many more bills have been introduced that do and will require increased county spending.




WHEREAS, The people of the counties have been forced to meet these required expenditures through the use of the property tax.

Proposed operations will begin, on or after the 18th day of March, 1977.



SPECIAL ROAD USE AGREEMENT CONTRACT

THE STATE OF TEXAS X
COUNTY OF UPSHUR X KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

The undersigned, Western Gas Corporation, hereinafter referred to as First Party, enters into and makes an agreement with Upshur County Commissioner of Precinct No. 4, Upshur County, Texas, and in order to get material to and from its drilling operations, it is necessary to use a portion of Upshur County roads located in Precinct No. 4, over which Commissioner has jurisdiction and obligation to maintain in good repair and both parties being aware of possible damage to said roads as a result of hauling on and over same enter into the following agreement.

1.

First Party agrees to use only those sections of roads as shown on Exhibit "A" attached.

2.

First Party agrees to use its vehicles in such a manner as not to block or interfere with other traffic on said road so that said road will be open to travel by the public at all times.

3.

First Party agrees to grade, maintain and otherwise repair said road using its own equipment, labor and materials, if any needed, during the duration of time that First Party is conducting drilling operations on its lands located in Precinct No. 4, Upshur County.

4.

First Party agrees to put said road back into the same condition as it was prior to the commencement of drilling operations on the part of First Party.

5.

Nothing herein shall be construed as a waiver by the Commissioner of the authority granted him by Article 6716, V.A.C.S., but the rights and authority granted the Commissioner by the terms of Article 6716, V.A.C.S. are expressly reserved by the Commissioner in the event First Party fails to abide by the conditions above set forth.


