April 25, 1977

Commissioners Court met in Special Session with Bernice Nobles, Charles Still, Floyd Drennan and Judge Everett Dean present.

Mr. Tom McClurg, Jr., representative of the East Texas Human Development Corporation (HUDCO), met with the court to discuss the summer day care center program which is proposed for Upshur County. The court advised Mr. McClurg that they would be able to give him an answer on his proposal next Monday.

Mr. J.L. Donaldson, Director, Career Counseling and Placement for Jarvis Christian College, Hawkins, Texas, met with the court to discuss the day care program which they plan to have. This program would be a year round program to serve low income families.

Bernice Nobles made a motion, seconded by Charles Still, to approve a Special Road Use Agreement Contract from LASCO, Inc. to use roads in Prec. #3 necessary to reach timber. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Floyd Drennan, seconded by Charles Still, to approve a permit application from Robert E. Nelson to place a driveway culvert on ROW of Woodchuck Road. Motion carried. (Permit attached)

The Deputation of Pat Williams was approved by Commissioners Court. Copy of the Deputation is entered in the Court Minutes.

A motion was made by Floyd Drennan, seconded by Charles Still, to accept the offer of Mr. R.A. Hickerson to remove all the stumps on the courthouse yard for \$139.00. These stumps to be removed Saturday morning, April 30, 1977. Motion carried.

Judge Dean read the minutes of the previous meeting. A motion was made by Floyd Drennan and seconded by Everett Dean to approve the minutes as read. Motion carried.

Floyd Drennan made a motion, seconded by Charles Still, to approve five unpaid bills. Motion carried.

Charles Still made a motion, seconded by Bernice Nobles, to approve the Treasurer's Quarterly Report. Motion carried.

Charles Still made a motion, seconded by Bernice Nobles, to permit Judge Dean to write Senator Peyton McKnight expressing the court's opposition to Bill No. 968. Motion carried.

Floyd Drennan made a motion, seconded by Charles Still, that court adjourn. Motion carried.

COUNTY OF UPSHUR | KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

The undersigned, LASCO INC., hereinafter referred to as First Party, enters into and makes an agreement with Upshur County Commissioner of Precinct No. 3, Upshur County, Texas, and in order to get material to market it is necessary to use a portion of Upshur County roads located in Precinct No. 3, over which Commissioner has jurisdiction and obligation to maintain in good repair and both parties being aware of possible damage to said roads as a result of hauling on and over same enter into the following agreement.

1.

First Party agrees to use only that section of

TIMBER

2.

First Party agrees to use its vehicles in such a manner as not to block or interfere with other traffic on said road so that said road will be open to travel by the public at all times.

3.

First Party agrees to grade, maintain and otherwise repair said road using its own equipment, labor and materials, if any needed, during the duration of time that First Party is removing TIMBER from its lands located in Precinct No. 3, Upshur County.

4.

First Party agrees to put said road back into the same condition as it was prior to the commencement of hauling operations on the part of First Party.



OATH OF OFFICE


