Charles Still made a motion, seconded by J. W. Meadows to post notice of intent to issue certificates of obligation. Motion carried.

Keith Barber, County Auditor, swore in the Commissioners Court as the Board of Equalization.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD THAT IN THE FUTURE, SHOULD FOR ANY REASON UPSHUR COUNTY NEED TO WORK, IMPROVE, RELOCATE, WIDEN, INCREASE, ADD TO, OR IN MANNER CHANGE THE STRUCTURE OF THIS RIGHT-OF-WAY, THIS LINE, IF AFFECTED, WILL BE MOVED UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE UPSHUR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND SHALL BE RELOCATED AT THE COMPLETE EXPENSE OF THE OWNER.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT UPSHUR COUNTY ASSUMES NO LIABILITY FOR DAMAGES TO ANY LINE, POLE, CONSTRUCTION, OR APPURTENANCES IN THE NORMAL MAINTENANCE OF THE COUNTY ROAD.




