Mrs. Jo Etta York discussed maternity leave for Cynthia Shattles, Extension Agent, HE. The county will allow Mrs. Shattles 30 days sick leave with pay.

Motion was made by Floyd Drennan and seconded by Charles Still for the Upshur Rural Electric Coop. to relocate electric lines on F.M. 1002. The cost will be approximately \$2,000.00 but will not exceed \$2,500.00. Vote carried.

Don Hightower and Ronnie Mitchell of the probation office discussed the juvenile budget for 1978 with the Commissioners Court. The juvenile department will need \$13,141.00 for a five month period not funded by the state. If the Adult Probation Bill, which will provide 90¢ per day per adult probationer, passes the department will have adequate funds for the entire year. No action was taken.

Byron Spencer discussed with the commissioners the possibility of obtaining oil dirt for parking lots and roadways at the Gilmer Schools. No action was taken.

Motion was made by Charles Still and seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve a right of way application from General Telephone on Notawa Road. Vote carried.

Motion was made by J. W. Meadows and seconded by Bernice Nobles for payment of all bills now due and payable by Upshur County. Vote carried.

Motion was made by Charles Still and seconded by Floyd Drennan to adjourn. Vote carried.




