

RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF
UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING CONTRACT BETWEEN
UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS, AND MAURICE LOVE FOR THE PREPARATION OF COMPILED
DELINQUENT TAX RECORD.

" BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioner's Court of UPSHUR
County, Texas, that UPSHUR County, Texas, acting by and through
its duly elected, acting and qualified County Judge, the duly elected,
acting and qualified Commissioners of the Commissioners' Precincts
Numbered One, Two, Three and Four, and the duly elected, acting and
qualified Tax Assessor and Collector of UPSHUR County, Texas,
enter into a contract with Maurice Love, of Red River County, Texas,
for the compilation of a delinquent tax record, according to the terms
of a written contract, a copy of which is hereto attached and made a
part hereof; and that the above named officials of UPSHUR
County, Texas, be, and they are hereby, authorized to execute and
contract in behalf of UPSHUR County, Texas."

This Agreement is hereby made and entered into by and between
UPSHUR County, Texas, hereinafter called "First Party"
acting herein by and through its duly elected and acting Commissioners'
Court and Tax Assessor-Collector, and Maurice Love, hereinafter called
"Second Party":

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, Article 7336f, Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes, as amended, directs and authorizes the collector of taxes of UPSHUR County, Texas, to cause to be compiled a delinquent tax record of all taxes which have become delinquent and which have not been included in the compiled delinquent tax records of said County; and provides for the payment of the cost thereof, such cost in no case to exceed a sum equal to twenty cents (20¢) per item or written line of such records:

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed by and between said "First Party" and "Second Party" as follows:

1.

"Second Party" hereby agrees that he will furnish the necessary labor and perform the services necessary to compile and deliver, complete with recapitulation statement and ready for binding, an original compiled list of such delinquent taxes and two copies (the first copy of which said "Second Party" will deliver to the State), covering the years 1968 to 1975, both years inclusive, which shall be submitted to the Commissioners' Court of UPSHUR County, Texas, for correction and/or approval on or before the 1ST day of JUNE, 1977.

2.

"First Party" agrees that upon approval of said compiled list of delinquent taxes prepared by "Second Party" by the Commissioners' Court of UPSHUR County, Texas, it will pay to said "Second Party" for his services and labor a sum equal to twenty cents per item or written line of the original copy of such record. Such payment shall be made by

the Tax Collector of UPSHUR County, Texas, proportionately from each the State and County taxes, and other taxes due taxing units which are collected by said Tax Collector, first collected from such record.
