Commissioners Court met in Special session with all members of the Court present.

Judge Dean read the minutes of March 27, 1978 meeting. J. W. Meadows made a motion, seconded by Floyd Drennan for the minutes to stand as read. Motion carried.

Judge Dean opened bids on the sale of two (2) used motor graders. Bids were from Surplus Discount Center, Tyler, Texas with a bid of \$4,000.00 for both of the motor graders. Towers Used Trucks & Equipment of Paris, Texas bid \$2,802.00 for both machines. Sabine Machinery Co., of Dallas, Texas bid \$2,314.00 for both machines. Allen Machinery Co., Inc. of Longview made a bid on the two graders for \$6,000.00. Motion was made by Charles Still, seconded by Floyd Drennan to accept the bid from Allen Machinery Co. Motion carried. (copy of bids attached)

Bids were opened for buying of one (1) new motor grader. Bids were from Allen Machinery Co. of Longview, Texas. Other bids were from Sabine Machinery Co., of Dallas and Darr Equipment Co. of Longview, Texas. Motion was made by Charles Still, seconded by Floyd Drennan, to buy from Darr Equipment Co. on a lease rental purchase agreement of \$751.50 per month for 48 months, with a purchase option or residual value of \$32,000.00. Motion carried. (copy of all bids attached)

Wayne Wilson asked permission to buy two (2) batteries at \$55.57 each for the Civil Defense units. Charles Still made a motion, seconded by Floyd Drennan, for Mr. Wilson to buy the batteries. Motion carried.

Floyd Drennan made a motion, seconded by J. W. Meadows to approve a special road use agreement contract with Lee Ray, Inc. to use Bison Road in Precinct 4. Motion carried. (copy attached)

Charles Still made a motion, seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve a permit application from Etex Telephone Coop., Inc. to place a buried telephone cable on ROW of County Road in Precinct 3. Motion carried. (copy attached)

Verbal approval of this plan has been received from the CJD Grants Management Section. The Commissioner's Court of each county must endorse this plan and it must receive ETCOG and CJD approval before we are obligated.

The project is beneficial to our runaways and other minor offenders in that a good number have been diverted from detention during the past year. If this hadn't been done, the expense of operating each county's jail would have been greater, so the counties are also gaining from the project.






