

SUGGESTED SPECIFICATIONS

Motor Grader

85 Net Flywheel H.P.

It is the intent of these specifications to describe one new articulated frame motor grader of manufacturer's latest design and construction and furnished with all regular standard equipment.

ENGINE: Unit shall be powered by a diesel engine developing not less than 85 SAE rated net flywheel horsepower at 2,300 R.P.M. Engine shall include a pressure lubrication system with full flow filter, pressurized cooling system with thermostat and fixed bypass, suction type fan, dry type air cleaner with restriction indicator, 12 volt electrical system with alternator and 360 minute reserve capacity batteries.

TRANSMISSION: Unit shall be equipped with a power shift transmission providing a minimum of eight forward and four reverse speeds. Unit shall have a forward speed range of 0-21.6 m.p.h. and a reverse speed range of 0-7.1 m.p.h.

STEERING: Unit shall have hydraulic power steering.

BRAKES: Unit shall have hydraulically actuated wet disk brakes effective on four wheels and a mechanical parking brake.

CONTROLS: Because fully hydraulic controls are preferred, manufacturer shall supply all advertised blade control options.

BLADE: Unit shall be equipped with a 12 foot blade. Blade must be capable of lifting above ground 13 inches sideshifting 26 inches right and 31 inches left with shoulder reach outside the wheels of 5 feet 11 inches right and 6 feet 5 inches left.

TIRES: Unit shall be equipped with 15.5 X 25 8 PLY.

SCARIFIER: Unit shall be equipped with a "V" type scarifier.

CAB: Unit shall be equipped with a S&E standard J396 roll over canopy.

OTHER EQUIPMENT: Unit shall be equipped with a fully transistorized regulator, electric starter, electric hour meter, cigarette lighter, horn, air inlet capy, deluxe seat, water temperature gauge, engine oil pressure gauge, fuel gauge, running lights, pre-cleaner and ether starting aid.

OPERATING WEIGHT: Unit shall have a minimum operating weight of 20,000 pounds.

WARRANTY: Manufacturer shall provide oneyear factory warranty.

NOTE: All bidders must furnish with their bid detailed specifications and all other data necessary to describe the equipment which the bidder proposes to furnish.





WHEREAS, under the mandate of Title 2, Section 19.233, Texas Education Code, I am required upon receipt of such petition immediately to call an election to determine said proposition;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EVERETT DEAN, acting in my official capacity as County Judge of Upshur County, Texas, and under the mandate of Title 2, Section 19.233, Texas Education Code, do hereby order that an election be held on August 12, 1978, in the Ore City Independent School District, at the Ore City Library, located within the boundaries of said independent school district, to determine whether the City of Tall Pines, Texas, Municipal School District should be consolidated with the Ore City Independent School District; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Peggy Webster is hereby appointed judge and presiding officer of said election and Meredith Rawls, Bobbie Bowers, and Debbie Freeman are hereby appointed Clerks to assist her in holding same, and she shall within ten (10) days after said election has been held make due return to the County Judge and Commissioners Court of this County as is required by law; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that all persons who have attained the age of eighteen (18) years and who are legally qualified voters of this State and who have resided within the Ore City


Independent School District for the time prescribed by law, next preceding said election shall be entitled to vote at said election.
