



## UPSHUR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT

GILMER, TEXAS

August 14, 1978

Commissioners Court met in Regular Session with Commissioners, Floyd Drennan, Charles Still, Bernice Nobles, and Judge Dean. Commissioner J.W. Meadows was not present.

Judge Dean read the minutes of August 7, 1978. Motion was made by Charles Still, seconded by Floyd Drennan for the minutes to stand as read. Motion carried.

Charles Still made motion, seconded by Floyd Drennan that the court canvass the results of the Special Election of the Ore City School District. Motion carried. (Copy attached)

Mrs. Frances Willis with the M.H.M.R. met with the court to give a report and ask that the budget for the coming year be approved. The annual budget has already been approved by the court.

Judge Dean made motion, seconded by Bernice Nobles to appoint Rex Price as a Responsibility Committee of the M.H.M.R. Center. Motion carried.

Judge Dean made motion, seconded by Floyd Drennan to appoint Willie D. Finch for the M.H.M.R. Center's Board of Trustees to replace Stuart Daniels. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Floyd Drennan, seconded by Bernice Nobles for a plat to be placed in the court minutes and records for recording purposes only. The plat was presented to the court by Lowell Holt. Motion carried.

Constable Bill Byrd met with the court asking for help in any way they could for himself. This concerned the wreck he had in or near Ft. Worth back in June. No action was taken.

Permit application from Western Gas Corp. to place a buried pipeline across county roads, Armadillo Road and Mimosa Road. Motion was made by Floyd Drennan, seconded by Charles Still to approve this permit. Motion carried. (Copy attached)

Charles Still made motion, seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve two (2) permit applications from Pritchett Water Supply Corp. One permit to place a water line across county road, Locust Road. The other permit to place a water line within the ROW of county road, Aspen Trail. Motion carried. (Copies attached)

Bernice Nobles made motion, seconded by Charles Still to approve a permit application from David Wooten to place a driveway culvert within the ROW of county road, Smilax Trace Road. Motion carried. (Copy attached.)

Motion made by Bernice Nobles, seconded by Charles Still to approve a request for new employment of DeRhonda Kay Webb as a deputy clerk for the County Clerk's Office and James R. Weber as a road hand for Pct.# 1. Motion carried. (Copies attached)

Judge Dean read a letter addressed to the Missouri-Pacific Railroad, P.O. Box 8686, Shreveport, Louisiana concerning the railroad crossings in Upshur County. Motion was made by Charles Still, seconded by Floyd Drennan that this letter be mailed to this company. Motion carried. (Copy of letter attached)

Hal Newsome ask the court for an appointment as Deputy Constable of Pct. # 2 so he might hold his certification. Motion made to accept this appointment by Bernice Nobles, seconded by Floyd Drennan. Motion carried.

Floyd Drennan made motion, seconded by Judge Dean to approve the unpaid bills. Motion carried.

Court closed for an executive session.

SPECIAL ROAD USE AGREEMENT CONTRACT

THE STATE OF TEXAS X  
COUNTY OF UPSHUR X

The undersigned, Western Gas Corporation, hereinafter referred to as First Party, enters into and makes an agreement with Upshur County Commissioner of Precinct No. \_\_\_\_, Upshur County, Texas, and in order to get material to market, it is necessary to construct a pipeline across and within a portion of Upshur County roads located in Precinct No. \_\_\_\_, over which Commissioner has jurisdiction and obligation to maintain in good repair and both parties being aware of possible damage to said roads as a result of pipeline construction on and over same, enter into the following agreement.

1.

First Party agrees to use only those sections of roads as shown on Exhibit "A" attached.

2.

First Party agrees to construct its pipeline in such a manner as not to block or interfere with other traffic on said road so that said road will be open to travel by the public at all times.

3.

First Party agrees to grade, maintain and otherwise repair said road using its own equipment, labor and materials, if any needed, during the duration of time that First Party is conducting pipeline construction operations on its lands located in Precinct No. \_\_\_\_, Upshur County.

4.

First Party agrees to put said road back into the same condition as it was prior to the commencement pipeline construction operations on the part of the First Party.

5.

Nothing herein shall be construed as a waiver by the Commissioner of the authority granted him by Article 6716, V. A. C. S., but the rights and authority granted the Commissioner by the terms of Article 6716, V. A. C. S. are expressly reserved by the Commissioner in the event First Party fails to abide by the conditions above set forth.
