





CONTRACT FOR PROBATION SERVICES

PREAMBLE

We, the Texas County Commissioners Courts of Marion, Upshur, and Wood Counties, in order to provide effective probation services as an alternative to incarceration, and to provide protection to our communities by rehabilitation and adequate supervision of offenders, and to fully utilize available services from Federal, State, and local resources, do hereby contract, as provided in Texas Civil Statutes, Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes, Article 44.13 (32c) to organize such probation services, hereafter named M-U-W Probation System, to be administered by a board composed of the Judges of the Courts to be served, including the Judges of District Courts with jurisdiction in these Counties, and the County Judges of each County.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

This contract will become effective September 1, 1978, and will continue in effect under the above named Administrative Board. Administration will follow the policies established and published by the Board, revised effective September 1, 1978, such publication being available by request from either members of the Board or the Director of Probation Services.

Minutes of the meetings of the Board will be available upon request from the annually elected secretary of the Board.

Audit of the Probation System will be made at least annually, by an auditor appointed by agreement of the District Judges who are members of the Administrative Board.

A Director of Probation Services will be appointed by the Board and will be responsible to the Board for an effective and efficient administration of the System.

Payment of expenditures will be approved and the checks signed by the Director of Probation Services and two (2) of the three (3) officers

of the Board, to be reported in a financial report to the Administrative Board at its regular quarterly meeting. The respective county judge will then submit the financial report to his County Commissioners Court in their next regular meeting.

Personnel relationships for the probation staff will be assigned to Upshur County, the most populous County, in accord with Article 42.12, Section 10 (f) of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, for the purpose of "all District Probation Department staff to participate in that County's group insurance program; retirement plan; and personnel policies with regard to vacation credit, sick leave credit, military leave, etc.". Specific deviations from the personnel relationships of Upshur County may be made by the Board and entered into the policy statement. Only by such approval shall the deviation be effective. (See "Policy Statement")

It shall be the responsibility of the Counties "To provide physical facilities, equipment, and utilities for the effective and professional probation services". (Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, Article 42.12, Section 10 (f).)

"Salaries of personnel, and other expenses essential to the adequate supervision of probationers will be paid from the funds of the judicial district...". (Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, Article 42.12, Section 10 (h).)

Administrative Board members will receive an expense allowance of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), from the Probation System, for each Board Meeting attended.

ADULT PROBATION SERVICES

All fees originating in a respective county and received by the Probation Department will be deposited in the depository of that county during the month and distributed by the end of the month to the respective court clerks who are to receive an accounting of collected individual fines, court costs, restitution, appointed attorneys fees, etc.; and to the M-U-W Probation District Fund with an accounting of collected individual probation fees. These funds will be audited by the individual county auditors.

The M-U-W Probation fiscal officer will receive all probation fees

which will be deposited in a special fund of the Upshur County treasury designated "M-U-W Probation District Fund". State-aid funds, as defined in Article 42.121, Section 4.01, will be received by the fiscal officer and deposited in the same fund. These funds shall "be used solely for the provision of adult probation services and community-based correctional programs and facilities other than jails or prisons". (Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, Article 42.121, Section 4.05 (b).)

The fiscal officer shall provide efficient and accurate accounting records to be audited by the appointed auditor for the probation system, and will make financial reports to the Administrative Board, and will make financial records available to the Texas Adult Probation Commission as provided in the Statutes.

JUVENILE PROBATION SERVICES

Juvenile Probation Services are to be provided only to Upshur and Wood Counties effective September 1, 1978. Marion County Probation Services are provided under a special legislative statute for that County only.

The M-U-W Administrative Board excluding participation of Marion County representation, will be the Administrative Board for the juvenile system.

The Juvenile Court of Upshur and Wood Counties will cause to be submitted to each County Commissioners Court of those Counties a copy of the succeeding year's budget for the Juvenile Probation System for county budgeting during the month of June each year. The juvenile budget will report the financial support required from each county.

The Juvenile Probation System is authorized by the contract to seek out and to accept subject to approval of the Administrative Board, in accord with legislative statute, state-aid, grants, or gifts of the State (including school districts, county available school funds, and municipal) or associations and foundations for the sole purpose of financing adequate programs and services. All grants, gifts, and allocations of the character and purpose described in this section shall be handled and accounted for separately from other public funds of the county.

Payment of pro-rata support to the juvenile probation budget may be made either annually or on the first day of the month, in advance of planned expenditures from the budget, and to the Upshur-Wood County Juvenile Probation Department.

Funds received will be deposited by the fiscal officer in a special fund of the Upshur County treasury in the name of Upshur-Wood Juvenile Probation Department, and shall be used solely for the budgeted purposes of the Juvenile Probation Department. Line items of the budget may be adjusted only by action of the Administrative Board.

The fiscal officer shall provide efficient and accurate accounting records to be audited by the appointed auditor for the probation system, and the fiscal officer will make financial reports to the Administrative Board.

POLICY STATEMENT

A policy statement will be prepared reflecting the provisions of this contract.

The policy statement will specifically outline a program of salaries and salary review. It will also outline specific deviations from Upshur County personnel relationships, including payment of FICA taxes, withholding, unemployment insurance and workmen's compensation. No policy will be effective unless approved by the Administrative Board.

AMENDMENTS TO THIS CONTRACT

This contract may be amended by adoption of the Board by majority vote in favor of the proposed amendment and subsequent adoption and entry into the minutes of the respective County Commissioners Courts. Such minutes will be excerpted and attached to this contract and shall become a part of the contract.
