Those sections dealing with the Job Classification and Experience Scale, Working Hours, Vacation, and Holidays as stated are the policies for all county employees with the exception of the following job positions: Jailer-Dispatcher, Chief Jailer-Dispatcher, Deputy Sheriff, Assistant Investigator, Investigator, and Chief Deputy Sheriff. The policies for these employees on the above listed items are as follows:

Job Classification and Experience Scale - the base pay listed is not based upon a 40 hour work week as all other county employees. Rather, it is based upon a 6 days on, 2 days off schedule with no holidays.

Working Hours - will be those assigned by the Department Head.

Vacation - time will accrue like other employees and may be taken at the discretion of the Department Head, but pay-in-lieu of vacation time is not available.

Holidays - will be regular work days and no additional compensation will be allowed if this day falls during an employee's work schedule.

All other benefits and policies are the same as other county employees.




