SPECIAL ROAD USE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into by and between EXXON COMPANY, U.S.A. (a division of Exxon Corporation), herein called "Exxon," and the COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS,

W I T N E S S E T H :

WHEREAS, to secure and transport gravel for use in building and preparing Exxon's well locations at various sites in Upshur County, it is necessary for Exxon's contractor, Lee Ray, Contractor, Inc., to use a portion of an Upshur County road located in Precinct 3 over which the Commissioner for that Precinct has jurisdiction and the obligation to maintain said road in good repair; and

WHEREAS, both parties are aware of possible damage to said roads as a result of such use of said county road, and Exxon desires to assume responsibility for such damage to the extent herein provided:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein stated, it is agreed as follows:

1. Exxon agrees that its contractor will use for the purpose above recited, only that section of the county road shown in RED on the plat marked Exhibit "A," attached hereto, which section of road is hereinafter referred to as "the road." The term "the road" shall (for the purposes of this agreement) include any bridge or culvert located on or under said road. For convenience, the use of the road by the contractor will be referred to as Exxon's use.
2. Exxon agrees that such use will be made in such a manner as not to block or interfere with other traffic on the road, so that the road will be open to travel by the public at all times.
3. Exxon agrees to reimburse Upshur County for the reasonable costs of materials for maintaining and repairing the road during the time that Exxon's contractor is transporting gravel on and along said road, to the extent that such maintaining and repairing are necessary as the result of Exxon's use of the road. Exxon also agrees to reimburse Upshur County for such costs incurred in repairing the road following completion of use of the road by Exxon as herein provided, to the extent that such repairing is necessary as the result of Exxon's use of the road as provided herein. The approximate cost of materials to completely resurface a county road is \$6,000 per mile. The length of road to be used by Exxon is about one-half (1/2) mile. Therefore, Exxon agrees to reimburse the County for a maximum of its fair share of \$3,000.
4. During the time that Exxon is so using the road, if the County Commissioner of Precinct No. 3 proposes to perform any maintenance work or repairs on the road which said Commissioner deems necessary as the result of Exxon's use of the road, said Commissioner shall give notice to Exxon of the proposed action not less than forty-eight (48) hours in advance of the performance of said work. In such event, a joint inspection shall be made by an Upshur County representative and a representative of Exxon so that a mutual agreement can be reached,

if possible, as to the cause of the need for such maintenance or repair, and the nature and extent of the necessary repairs. Upon completion of Exxon's use of the road under this agreement, Exxon shall promptly give the County Commissioner of Precinct No. 3 notice of such fact, and promptly thereafter, a joint inspection shall be made by an Upshur County representative and a representative of Exxon so that a mutual agreement can be reached, if possible, as to the repairs which have become necessary by reason of Exxon's use of the road. Following each such joint inspection, the County of Upshur shall submit to Exxon a written estimate of the cost of materials for such necessary repairs. The notices herein provided for shall be given in writing, addressed to Exxon at P. O. Box 2025, Tyler, Texas 75710, and to the County Commissioner of Precinct No. 3 at P. O. Box 730, Gilmer, Texas 75644.

5. Payment by Exxon hereunder shall be made upon proof of expenditures, with evidence as to what the expenditures relate, together with a written statement signed by the County Judge of Upshur County, Texas, that such repair work has been completed in a matter satisfactory to the County.

6. Nothing herein shall be construed as a waiver by the Commissioner of Precinct No. 3 of the authority granted him by Article 6717, V.A.C.S. 9 but the rights and authority granted said Commissioner by the terms of said statute are expressly reserved by the Commissioner in the event Exxon fails to abide by the conditions herein stated.







THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into by and between EXXON COMPANY, U.S.A. (a division of Exxon Corporation), herein called "Exxon," and the COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS,

W I T N E S S E T H :

WHEREAS, for the drilling and completing of Exxon's wells on its Gladewater Gas Units No. 6 and No. 7, and the construction of Exxon's Gladewater separation station in the Gladewater Area, the locations of which are shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto, in Upshur County, Texas, it is necessary to transport well drilling and well servicing units and other vehicles hauling materials and equipment over a portion of Upshur County roads located in Precinct No. 1, over which the Commissioner of that Precinct has jurisdiction and the obligation to maintain said roads in good repair; and

WHEREAS, both parties are aware of possible damage to said roads as a result of Exxon's hauling and transporting said equipment on and over said roads:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein stated, it is agreed as follows:

1. Exxon agrees to use for the purposes above recited, only that section of the county roads shown in RED on the plat marked Exhibit "A," attached hereto, which section of road is hereinafter referred to as "the road." The term "the road" shall (for the purposes of this agreement) include any bridge or culvert located on or under said road.

2. Exxon agrees to use its vehicles in such a manner as not to block or interfere with other traffic on the road, so that the road will be open to travel by the public at all times.

3. Exxon agrees to reimburse Upshur County for the reasonable costs of materials for maintaining and repairing the road during the time that Exxon is transporting well drilling equipment, well servicing units, other equipment and materials to and from the sites identified above, to the extent that such maintaining and repairing are necessary as the result of Exxon's use of the road. Exxon also agrees to reimburse Upshur County for such costs incurred in repairing the road following completion of use of the road by Exxon as herein provided, to the extent that such repairing is necessary as the result of Exxon's use of the road as provided herein. The approximate cost of materials to completely resurface a county road is \$6,000.00 per mile. The length of roads to be used by Exxon is about two and two-tenths (2.2) miles. Therefore, Exxon agrees to reimburse the County for a maximum of its fair share of \$13,200.

4. During the time that Exxon is so using the road if the County Commissioner of Precinct No. 1 proposes to perform any maintenance work or repairs on the road which said Commissioner deems necessary as the result of Exxon's use of the road, said Commissioner shall give notice to Exxon of the proposed action not less than forty-eight (48) hours in advance of the performance of said work. In such event, a joint inspection shall be made by an Upshur County representative and a

representative of Exxon so that a mutual agreement can be reached, if possible, as to the cause of the need for such maintenance or repair, and the nature and extent of the necessary repairs. Upon completion of Exxon's use of the road under this agreement, Exxon shall promptly give the County Commissioner of Precinct No. 1 notice of such fact, and promptly thereafter, a joint inspection shall be made by an Upshur County representative and a representative of Exxon so that a mutual agreement can be reached, if possible, as to the repairs which have become necessary by reason of Exxon's use of the road. Following each such joint inspection, the County of Upshur shall submit to Exxon a written estimate of the cost of materials for such necessary repairs. The notices herein provided for shall be given in writing, addressed to Exxon at P. O. Box 2025, Tyler, Texas 75710, and to the County Commissioner of Precinct No. 1 at P. O. Box 730, Gilmer, Texas 75644.

5. Exxon and the County Commissioners further agree that Lee Ray Contractor, Inc. will replace the wooden bridge which is located on the road with two (2) 48-inch corrugated steel culverts, covered with gravel and topped with road oil, the same as is on the balance of the road. The replacement of the bridge is necessary to support Exxon's equipment and drilling rig. Exxon will reimburse the County for the entire cost of this work after Lee Ray Contractor, Inc., bills the County.

6. Payment by Exxon hereunder shall be made upon proof of expenditures, with evidence as to what the expenditures relate, together with a written statement signed by the County Judge of Upshur County, Texas, that such repair work has been completed in a manner satisfactory to the County. The statement of costs for the bridge replacement shall be supported by copy of the invoice therefor from Lee Ray Contractor, Inc.

7. Nothing herein shall be construed as a waiver by the Commissioner of Precinct No. 1 of the authority granted to him by Article 6717, V.A.C.S., but the rights and authority granted said Commissioner by the terms of said statute are expressly reserved by the Commissioner in the event Exxon fails to abide by the conditions herein stated.


