



UPSHUR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT

June 26, 1980

The Commissioners Court of Upshur County in regular session met with the County Judge to discuss the budget needs of Upshur County for 1980-81 Fiscal Year. Due to the increased cost of materials and services purchased by Upshur County to perform the functions of County government and an urgent need for cost of living adjustments in employees wages, County revenues must be increased.

It is therefore resolved by Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas to instruct the Tax Assessor-Collector of Upshur County to raise the ratio of assessments on the County tax roll from 37½% to 45% of value. This 20 % increase in assessment is necessary to meet the financial needs of Upshur County for the budget year of 1980-81.

This resolution voted on and passed this the 26th day of June, 1980.



COUNTY OF UPSHUR | KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

The undersigned, Lasco, Inc.,
hereinafter referred to as First Party, enters into and makes
an agreement with Upshur County Commissioner of Precinct No. 3,
Upshur County, Texas, and in order to get material to market
it is necessary to use a portion of Upshur County roads located
in Precinct No. 3, over which Commissioner has jurisdiction
and obligation to maintain in good repair and both parties
being aware of possible damage to said roads as a result of
hauling on and over same enter into the following agreement.

First Party agrees to use only that section of

First Party agrees to use its vehicles in such a
manner as not to block or interfere with other traffic on said
road so that said road will be open to travel by the public
at all times.

First Party agrees to grade, maintain and otherwise
repair said road using its own equipment, labor and materials,
if any needed, during the duration of time that First Party
is removing timber from its lands located
in Precinct No. 3, Upshur County.

First Party agrees to put said road back into the
same condition as it was prior to the commencement of hauling
operations on the part of First Party.
