August 18, 1980

Commissioners' Court met in Special Session with all members present.

Judge Dean read the minutes of August 11, 1980. Motion was made by J. W. Meadows seconded by Floyd Drennan for the minutes to stand as read. Motion carried.

Justice of the Peace of Precinct #1, W. V. Ray, met with the court asking permission to hire JoAnn Wright as Deputy for his office. Motion was made by Judge Dean, seconded by Bernice Nobles, for Mrs. Wright to work as the Deputy Clerk for the Justice of the Peace. Motion carried.

Ralph Collins, City Mayor of East Mountain, met with the court asking the court for assistance in getting top priority from the State Department on county road Pleasant Trail Road in the city of East Mountain. It was advised by the court that it would be placed on the agenda and the court would sign the resolution for his request of first priority on this road.

Also, it was his request for the county to pay for the ROW of the Highway 300 through the city of East Mountain and then the city of East Mountain would pay the 10% which the state did not pay to the county, perhaps within 2 years. Dear Judge and Commissioners:

Article 6819a-18a, Texas Revised Civil Statutes, enacted by the 62nd Legislature, authorized supplemental pay for the Justices of the Courts of Civil Appeals from the counties in the court's judicial district. A majority of the Courts of Civil Appeals in Texas are presently receiving such a supplement.

Pursuant to the above statute, the 12th Court of Civil Appeals is requesting of your Commissioners Court a modest supplemental pay in the amount of \$16.92 per month for each of the three justices of this court. We are making a similar request of all the counties in our district, in each instance the amount requested being a percentage figure based on the county's population according to the 1970 Federal Census.

Enclosed herewith are copies of the statute and a schedule showing the percentage amounts requested from all the counties in our district.

We sincerely hope you see fit to honor this request in making up your budget for the coming year.
