Commissioners' Court met in Special Session with all members of the court present.

The minutes of the court of August 25, 1980, were read by Judge Dean. Motion was made by J. W. Meadows, seconded by Bernice Nobles, for the minutes to stand approved as read. Motion carried.

Don Gaddis, Veteran's Service Officer, made the request that he attend the Annual Statewide Conference for Veterans Service Officers October 20-24, 1980, at the El Tropicano Hotel, 110 Lexington Avenue, San Antonio, Texas. Motion by Floyd Drennan, seconded by J. W. Meadows, that he go to the conference. Motion carried.

Permit Application submitted by Linder Lenhart to place a water line within the ROW of County Road Rob White Road. Motion by Bernice Nobles, seconded by J. W. Meadows, to approve the permit application. Motion carried. (Copy attached)

**SPECIFICATIONS FOR SELF-PROPELLED HEAVY
DUTY BOOM-MOUNTED HYDRAULIC BRUSH CUTTER**

GENERAL

This specification covers a heavy duty hydraulic rotary brush cutter mounted on a rubber tired power unit to cut vegetation, brush, saplings and grass in areas not accessible to conventional type mowing equipment. A five foot heavy duty rotary head is mounted on the outer end of an extendable one piece boom. The cutter head is supported by full length replaceable skid shoes.

POWER UNIT

Specific

Tires: Front 7.50 x 16-6 ply. Rear 18.4 x 30.6 ply R-1. Left rear tire contains 960 lbs CaCl₂ solution.

Transmission: Manual shift - 8 forward speeds, 2 reverse speeds (minimum).

Brakes: Soft energizing wet disc enclosed in final drive.

Electrical System: 12 volt, 32 amp alternator, 128 amp battery. Lighted instrument panel; fuel gauge; water temperature gauge; warning lights-oil pressure; alternator; two head lights; tail light; flashing safety lights.

Three point hitch: Live hydraulics, 540 P.T.O.

Capacities: Fuel - 20 gallons crankcase 9 quarts
Cooling system - 15.3 quarts.

Steering: Power assist.

Engine: Horsepower P.T.O. - 70 h.p. 4 cylinder
Bore and stroke 4.4' x 4.2'
Compression ratio - 16.3:1
Rated engine speed 2100 RPM
Starter-electric starter with safety switch.

Other Equipment: Flat top fenders, horizontal exhaust, Roll Bar, seal belt; Oil bath air cleaner, fuel filter; Tool box (fender mounted).

CUTTER UNIT

Frame, tank and counterweight:

Frame shall be heavy duty saddle mount construction so as to withstand stresses of use in rugged terrain. The frame shall be designed so that hydraulic oil can be returned thru the framework thus providing additional cooling surface for the oil. No oil radiator should be required to maintain oil temperature below 75° + Ambient temperature. Example: if Ambient temperature is 85° F then (85° + 75° = 160°) oil temperature shall not exceed 160°F.

Hydraulic system:

Hydraulic system must be completely separate from tractor system so that tractor hydraulics can be used for other equipment, if necessary. Hydraulic pump shall be two stage with direct drive to tractor engine. One pump section shall drive the cutterhead, it shall be rated at 29 gpm at 2000 PSI when turned at 1800 RPM. The second pump section shall be rated 7 gpm at 1500 PSI when turned at 1800 RPM.

Cutter head positioning devices:

Boom lift cylinder - 77°
Boom swing cylinder - 101°
Head tilt cylinder - 90°
Boom winch - 6'6" minimum reach
22'8" maximum reach

Cutter head:

Cutter head width - 60" minimum motor speed with no load - 900 RPM. Tip speed of blades 14,000 ft./min. Deck material - 10 ga. minimum. Output shaft - minimum 1 31/32" dia. Cutter blades are a minimum length of 14 1/2", thickness of 5/8", and width of 5".

Reaches of cutter head from center line of tractor:

Below grade - 11'5".
At grade - 21'6".
Level - 22'8".
Above grade 18'6".

Operator protection:

Expanded metal cage on right side and top of operator position.
