October 20, 1980

Commissioners' Court met in Special Session with all members present.

Judge Dean read the minutes of October 13, 1980. Motion by J. W. Meadows, seconded by Charles Still, for the minutes to stand approved as read. Motion carried.

Mrs. Janis Choate, District Extension Director, met with the Court introducing Mr. Glenn Aubrey. J. W. Meadows made the motion, seconded by Charles Still, that Glenn Aubrey be selected as Extension Agent for Upshur County. Motion carried.

Motion by J. W. Meadows, seconded by Floyd Drennan, to approve the recommendation from District Judge Virgil Mulanax for the salary of County Auditor Keith Barber to be \$17,316.00 annually, effective October 1, 1980. Motion carried. (Copy attached)

Floyd Drennan made the motion, seconded by J. W. Meadows, for pay day for October to be made October 31. Motion carried.

Motion by Charles Still, seconded by J. W. Meadows, to approve a Contract Agreement between the City of Big Sandy, Texas and Upshur County Commissioners' Court. Motion carried. (Copy attached)

Motion by Floyd Drennan, seconded by J. W. Meadows, to approve the increasing rate of deposits of employees on total compensation from six per cent (6%) to seven per cent (7%). Motion carried. (Copy attached)

Motion by Bernice Nobles, seconded by Charles Still, to purchase the road grader from George P. Bane instead of extending the lease agreement. The balance to complete the contract is \$13,100.00. This contract is recorded in Volume 20 of the Commissioners' Court Minutes, Page 633. Motion carried.

Motion by Charles Still, seconded by Floyd Drennan, to advertise for bids for the roof to be placed on the Rock Building including labor and materials. Bids to be opened October 31, 1980, at 9:00 A.M. Motion carried.

Motion by J. W. Meadows, seconded by Floyd Drennan, to approve the unpaid bills. Motion carried.

Floyd Drennan made the motion, seconded by J. W. Meadows, to adjourn. Motion carried.

WHEREAS, the compensation of the County Auditor for Upshur County, Texas, has heretofore been set at an amount not more than that paid the Tax Assessor-Collector per year and has been approved by the Commissioners Court for that amount:

NOW, therefore, I, VIRGIL E. MULANAX, Judge, 115th Judicial District Court, the Court having jurisdiction in Upshur County, Texas, do hereby set the compensation of the County Auditor of Upshur County, in the amount of Seventeen Thousand Three Hundred and Sixteen (\$17,316.00) Dollars annually, effective October 1, 1980.

The salary herein provided shall be paid in equal monthly installments at the end of each calendar month.

This Order shall be entered in the Minutes of the 115th Judicial District Court of Upshur County, Texas, and be certified by the Clerk of said Court to the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, which shall cause the same to be entered in the Minutes with appropriate Order directing payment of the salary.

SUBJECT: A Contract between City of Big Sandy, Texas and Upshur County
Commissioners Court

AUTHORITY: Art. 4413 (32-C) or the Interlocal Cooperation Act.

PURPOSE: The City does propose to contract with Upshur County Road & Bridge Dept. to exchange labor, material and equipment use to mutually benefit both parties in the improvement of city streets and adjacent county roads.

AGREEMENT: The City agrees to furnish to the County refinery grade asphalt base road oil and sand material for the oil sand mix in an amount sufficient to cover several city streets and the adjacent county roads. To supplement county equipment and labor the city will make available the street maintenance equipment and labor controlled by the city to complete these projects. The City agrees to furnish a like amount of equipment hours and labor on adjacent county roads as the County Road & Bridge expends on any city streets.

It is understood by both parties that the City of Big Sandy and Upshur County will pay for these services with funds currently available to each party.

It is understood by both parties that any civil liabilities related to the furnishing of these services is the responsibility of the party receiving the services.

It is the desire of the City of Big Sandy to enter into this contract with Upshur County and accomplish these objectives to the mutual benefit of the City of Big Sandy and the County of Upshur.

COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER
INCREASING RATE OF DEPOSITS OF EMPLOYEES ON TOTAL COMPENSATION

THE STATE OF TEXAS
COUNTY OF UPSHUR

On this the 20 day of October, 1980, the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, was convened in special session, with the following members present, to-wit:

Everett Dean, County Judge
Bernice Nobles, Commissioner, Precinct No. 1,
J. W. Meadows, Commissioner, Precinct No. 2,
Charles Still, Commissioner, Precinct No. 3,
Floyd Drennan, Commissioner, Precinct No. 4,
J. B. Hill, Jr., County Clerk;

and at such session, among other proceedings, the following order was passed:

WHEREAS, by virtue of an order of the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, adopted on the 13 day of January, 1975, provided that each employee of the County should make deposits to the Texas County and District Retirement System for each payroll period at the rate of six per centum (6%) of earnings; and that the County should make deposits for each payroll period in an amount equal to the sum of deposits made to the System by all its employees for such period ; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court finds that it is to the public interest that the rate of deposits to the System be increased; now therefore,

BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. For each payroll period from and after the 1st day of October, 1980, each employee of Upshur County shall make deposits to the Texas County and District Retirement System at the rate of seven per centum (7%) of earnings; and such deposits shall be withheld by the County Auditor from the compensation of the employee and transmitted to the System for deposit to the individual account of such employee.

2. The County shall make benefit contributions to the System in an amount which for each payroll period is equal to the sum of deposits made to the System by all of its employees for such period.

The above order being read, it was moved and seconded that the same do pass and be adopted. Thereupon, the question being called for, the following members voted Aye: Dean, Nobles, Meadows, Still, Drennan; and the following voted No: none.
