Commissioners Court met February 9, 1981 in a Regular Session with J. W. Meadows absent due to illness.

Judge Dean read the minutes of February 2, 1981 meeting. Delmo Lawson made the motion seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve the minutes to stand as read. Motion carried.

Motion made by Charles Still seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve the attendance of the County Clerk and District Clerk at their Area V Meeting in Tyler, Texas February 18, 1981. Motion carried.

Permit application submitted by Herbert O. Thompson to install a culvert within the Right of Way of county road Mulberry Road. Charles Still made the motion seconded by Delmo Lawson to approve the application. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion made by Floyd Drennan seconded by Charles Still to approve a permit application submitted by Ronald Gantt to install a culvert within the Right of Way of county road Cherokee Trace. Motion carried. Copy attached.

A permit application was submitted by Western Gas Corporation to place a buried pipeline within the Right of Way crossing a county road in Precinct #4 to service the Larsson Well. Motion made by Floyd Drennan seconded by Charles Still to approve. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Permit application submitted by Western Gas Corporation to place a buried pipeline within the Right of Way of a county road in Precinct #4 to service the Williams Well. Motion made by Floyd Drennan seconded by Charles Still to approve. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Ronald Poole submitted a permit application to place a water line within the Right of Way of county road Aster Road. Charles Still made the motion seconded by Delmo Lawson to approve. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion made by Charles Still seconded by Delmo Lawson to place a letter from District Judge, Virgil E. Mulanax appointing Keith Barber County Auditor, in the court minutes. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion made by Charles Still seconded by Floyd Drennan to place a Certification of Compliance received by Dale Jewkes upon a recent inspection of the Upshur County Jail in the court minutes. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Judge Dean opened the only bid received for the Photostatic Photocopy Machine currently in the County Clerk's office. The bid was from Burnice Ashbrook in the amount of \$1.00. This bid was turned over to the county auditor for the present.

Charles Still made the motion seconded by Delmo Lawson to close court for an Executive Session. Motion carried.

Court reopened at 10:50 A.M.

Mr. Bybee Weisinger, Lumuel S. Guest, & Rowland Stuckey from the State Department of Highways & Public Transportation met with the court to discuss the Right of Way of Hwy. 300 pertaining to the part in the City of East Mountain. After a lengthy discussion Judge Dean asked that the State Department of Highways & Public Transportation contact the City of East Mountain and get the necessary agreements signed by them. At this time no action can be taken without the City of East Mountain's permission.

Charles Still made the motion seconded by Delmo Lawson to adjourn until 1:30 P.M.

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Court reopened at 1:30 P.M.

Judge Dean presented to the court a bid for Depository from Gilmer National Bank, which was the only bid submitted. The certified check of good faith was not included with the bid therefore disqualifying this bid. As this bid was rejected, the court will again advertise for bids to be opened February 23, 1981. Special Road Use Agreement from Coleman Trucking Company to use ^{Red} Marble Road in Precinct #3 for hauling gravel. Charles Still made the motion seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion made by Charles Still seconded by Delmo Lawson to renew the Ambulance Service for Upshur County for each Precinct Commissioner & his employees, for the County Courthouse employees and also the Prisoners. Motion carried.

He also gave the Financial Statement & Accountants Report of the audit up to and including Sept. 30, 1980. Motion made by Delmo Lawson seconded by Floyd Drennan to accept this audit. Motion carried.

Floyd Drennan made the motion seconded by Charles Still to approve the unpaid bills. Motion carried. Copy attached.



Gentlemen:

The Gilmer National Bank submits the following bid to become depository for Upshur County for the year 1981-82.

I. DEPOSITORY

The Bank does hereby agree to maintain all accounts of the County according to the wishes and desires of the County, or its proper and legally designated representative or representatives, in compliance with all the provisions of the laws of the State of Texas relating to the County fund depositories. In this connection, it is expressly understood that the County shall have the power to determine and designate the character and amount of County funds which shall be "demand deposits" and what character and amount of funds shall be "time deposits".

II. SECURITIES PLEDGE

The Bank agrees to execute a depository pledge contract with the County and to pledge acceptable securities in compliance with the Statutes of the State of Texas in an amount determined by the County as necessary in securing any and all deposits of the County's Public Funds. It is agreed that the County shall reserve the right to alter from time to time the required amount of securities to be sufficiently adequate to protect said funds and to approve or reject the securities so pledged. It is further understood that the Bank shall have the right and privilege of substituting securities upon

obtaining approval of the County, provided the total amount of securities deposited is adequate under the law.

III. RATE GUARANTEE


Certificates of \$100,000.00 or more will pay the same rate as that paid for \$10,000.00 money market certificates for 26 weeks. This rate, according to Regulation Q, will be one-quarter per cent above the rate for United States Treasury Bills immediately prior to the date of the deposit or certificate. It shall be binding only until the maturity of the certificate.

The interest rate for time deposits under \$100,000.00 shall be the maximum rate offered according to Regulation Q at the time the deposit or certificate is written. It shall be binding only until the maturity of the certificate.

IV. OTHER SERVICES

The Bank agrees to furnish deposit slips for all of the accounts, money bags and a monthly bank statement on each account without charge to the County. We will also act as paying agent for principal and/or interest on County bonds without charge. We will furnish bags and keys as needed for night depository without cost to the County. We will help in any financial and accounting counseling that might be needed. We will handle all County accounts in accordance with generally accepted banking practice.
