



UPSHUR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT

GILMER, TEXAS

October 12, 1981

Commissioners Court met in regular session with all members present.

Judge Dean read the minutes of the October 5, 1981 meeting. Motion was made by Commissioner Delmo Lawson and seconded by Commissioner J. W. Meadows for the minutes to stand approved as read. Motion carried.

Commissioners Court closed for an Executive Session at 9:05 A.M.

Court reopened at 9:55 A.M.

County Auditor, Keith Barber, read the financial report for the 1980-81 year.

Constable Harold Anderson met with the Court asking for the Court to approve the installation of a siren in his car. Anderson stated that Ernie Jones had a new unit, completely installed for approximately \$300.00. Motion by Floyd Drennan and seconded by Charles Still to approve the installation. Motion carried.

Motion by Charles Still and seconded by Delmo Lawson to approve a request by Johnny Miller to attend the divisional meeting of the Texas Professional Health Association to be held in Grand Prairie, Texas, October 15 and 16. Motion carried.

Sgt. Billy Davis, with the Department of Public Safety, met with the Court to ask the County to purchase two radar units for the DPS. The cost of each unit is \$3,295.00. Sgt. Davis was told that this would be on the agenda for the next meeting.

District Attorney, Dwight Brannon, asked for the payment of two bills for witnesses who testified in District Court. Motion by J. W. Meadows and seconded by Charles Still to approve these payments. Motion carried.

Sheriff Dale Jewkes met with the Court asking them to pass a resolution for the County to pay \$3,082.00, which is 25% of the total cost of one mobile unit and six walkie-talkies. Judge Dean told Sheriff Jewkes that this could be taken care of.

Sheriff Jewkes also asked the Commissioners to consider amending his budget because he did not figure the above mentioned \$3,082.00 in his original budget.

Sheriff Jewkes asked for a change of personnel from Jailer Dispatcher to Jailer Deputy position. He said that he would be filling this position by November 1, 1981. Motion by Charles Still and seconded by Delmo Lawson to approve this change. Motion carried.

Sheriff Jewkes asked the Court to consider a resolution for a reserve unit of ten people. Jewkes stated that he had originally requested a thirty person unit, but it would be hard to find ten qualified people to fill these positions. No action was taken at this time.

County Auditor, Keith Barber asked the Court to approve five Public Employees Blanket Bonds. The bonds are for the Upshur County Sheriff's Department, Upshur County Justice of The Peace, Upshur County District Clerk, Upshur County Auditor, and the Upshur County District Attorney. Motion by J. W. Meadows seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve these bonds. Motion carried.

Motion made by J. W. Meadows and seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve permit application submitted by Marsha Williams to place culvert within ROW of Keiffer Road. Motion carried. Copy attached.

County Auditor, Keith Barber asked the Court for the authority to contact an auditing firm for a proposal on the 1980-81 audit. Barber said that funds for this audit have already been allocated Motion by Charles Still and seconded by J. W. Meadows to approve this request. Motion carried.

Motion by Floyd Drennan seconded by Charles Still to approve a permit application by Perry Jones to place a culvert in the ROW of Mimosa Road. Motion carried. Copy attached.



