

**UPSHUR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT**

GILMER, TEXAS

November 9, 1981

Commissioners Court met in Regular Session with Judge Dean, Commissioners Charles Still, Floyd Drennan and Delmo Lawson present. Commissioner J. W. Meadows was absent.

Judge Dean read the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion by Charles Still seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve the minutes as read.

Sheriff Dale Jewkes presented to the Court a resolution authorizing the Sheriff to appoint no more than ten Reserve Deputy Sheriffs who will serve without compensation and in a capacity so designated by the Sheriff. Motion by Delmo Lawson seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve the resolution. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve the deputation of Frank T. Bless as Deputy Sheriff. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Winston Kelly, Mayor of West Mountain met with the Court asking what progress had been made on the contract between the County and the City of West Mountain for road work. Mr. Kelly was told that the County Auditor is working on figures for the cost of the road work and as soon as these figures are available work can begin on the contract.

County Clerk, J. B. Hill, Jr. presented the Court with a list of the Precinct Chairmen for the 1981-82 year. Motion by Charles Still seconded by Delmo Lawson to approve the list and place the list in the Court minutes. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Delmo Lawson to amend the budget to cover the costs of the radar units purchased for the Department of Public Safety. Motion carried.





BE IT REMEMBERED that at a regular meeting of the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, held on 9 day of November, 1981, on motion made by Delmo Lawson Commissioner of Precinct 1, and seconded by Floyd Drennan Commissioner of Precinct 4, the following order was adopted:

WHEREAS, Article 6869 V. C. S. authorizes the Sheriff to appoint Deputies in his respective County and Article 6869.1 authorizes the Commissioners Court in each County in the State of Texas to authorize the Sheriff to appoint Reserve Deputy Sheriffs.

BE IT ENACTED by the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas a resolution authorizing the Sheriff to appoint no more than 10 Reserve Deputy Sheriffs who will serve without compensation and in a capacity so designated by the Sheriff.

EACH Reserve Deputy so appointed and sworn shall file an oath and a bond in the amount of \$2,000.00, payable to the Sheriff. Premium on said bond to be paid from the General Fund of this County.

SUCH Reserve Deputy Sheriffs shall serve when called by the Sheriff and shall be bound to meet all minimum requirements established by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Officers Standards and Education and all other articles and statutes governing said Law Enforcement or Reserve Offices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this resolution will go into effect on November 9, 1981.
