



## UPSHUR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT

GILMER, TEXAS

February 22, 1982

Commissioners Court met in Special Session with Commissioners Floyd Drennan, Charles Still, J. W. Meadows, and Delmo Lawson present. Judge Dean was absent from the meeting. Commissioner Charles Still presided.

Supt. Tommy Ferguson, with the Ore City School District, met with the Court representing the area schools in Upshur County concerning the distribution of the available school funds, which have in the past been used for the Area Vocational School. After some discussion, Mr. Ferguson was told by the Court that in the near future, each school district will receive a questionnaire. After the questionnaire has been filled out and returned, the Court will begin the process and work it out as they can.

Motion was made by Floyd Drennan seconded by Charles Still for the minutes of the previous meeting to be read. Motion carried.

Upshur County would like to cooperate with the Texas Department of Agriculture and United States Department of Agriculture on the fire ant cost-sharing program for AMDRO.

Option number 2 (use of Amdro through bait distribution) was selected as our best means to control this pest. Amdro in 25 pound bags will be the only product distributed by Upshur County.

We are requesting 619 twenty-five pound bags of AMDRO. This amount will be distributed to 291 landowners with existing fire ant problems in Upshur County.

The county will deliver a check for the amount upon request. Any further information that concerns the fire ant program, please let us know.

Thanks for your cooperation on this problem that concerns many Upshur County landowners.

INTERLOCAL GOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

STATE OF TEXAS :

COUNTY UP SHUR :

THIS AGREEMENT made this 22 day of February, 1981, by and between the COUNTY OF UPSHUR, TEXAS, by and through the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, hereinafter called "Upshur County", and the CITY OF LONGVIEW, TEXAS, by and through its Mayor, hereinafter called "Longview":

R E C I T A L S:

A. A portion of State Highway 300 is within the corporate limits of the City of Longview, Texas, and in Upshur County, Texas; and

B. Upshur County, in cooperation with the Texas Department of Highways and Public Transportation, is in the process of acquiring right-of-way for State Highway 300 through a portion of Upshur County, Texas;

C. Longview has requested that Upshur County act as its agent in the acquisition of right-of-way for the construction of State Highway 300 over that portion of the highway within the corporate limits of the City of Longview and in Upshur County, and Longview will pay its proportionate share of the cost of acquisition of right-of-way and other costs required to be paid by local governmental agencies.

W I T N E S S E T H:

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises, and other considerations herein stated, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Longview hereby appoints and constitutes Upshur County as its agent for the sole and only purpose of acquiring right-of-way for that portion of State Highway 300 set forth in Exhibit "A" hereof, whether such acquisition is by voluntary conveyance or proceedings in eminent domain. Upshur County is authorized

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to take such action and execute such documents as may be necessary or desirable with respect to the acquisition of such right-of-way.

2. Upshur County agrees to keep Longview advised of all action taken or proposed to be taken by it with respect to the acquisition of such right-of-way.

3. Longview agrees to pay on request its ten (10%) per cent portion of the cost of acquisition of right-of-way, the remaining ninety (90%) per cent to be paid by the Texas Department of Highways and Public Transportation, over and across that portion of State Highway 300 set forth in Exhibit "A" hereof. Longview further agrees to reimburse Upshur County for any costs paid or incurred by Upshur County with respect to its acting as agent for Longview in connection with the acquisition of right-of-way for State Highway 300.

4. Longview agrees to cooperate with Upshur County in its carrying out the duties and obligations placed on Upshur County under the terms of this Agreement.

5. This Agreement is made and entered into under and pursuant to the terms of Article 4413 (32c) of the Texas Revised Civil Statutes.

6. Neither party shall assign this Agreement to any other party, whether an individual, corporation, or governmental agency without the express written consent of the other party.



Dear Judge Dean:

Senate Bill 151, relative to distribution of lateral road funds by the State Treasurer, was passed by the 67th Legislature. Under Section 2 (7), a portion of the allocation formula is based upon the lateral road mileage records of this Department as of January 1 of the year of allocation.

This is to advise you that the records of this Department do not reflect the necessary data to comply with S. B. 151. Our records are compiled and maintained for mapping purposes within limited personnel constraints and are, therefore, not current by any means. Also, identification of facilities inventoried are only by highway, city street, and other public roads.

In order to comply with S. B. 151 and permit proper disposition of funds as provided therein, it behooves us to establish the necessary data file by the most expedient measures. Therefore, this is to request that you furnish this Department with a certified Commissioners' Court Order reflecting the lateral road mileage within your county as of January 1, 1982. Lateral roads are those county roads that had not become a part of the system of State Designated Highways by January 1, 1982. Subsequent annual revisions to the inventory data thus obtained will be dependent upon receipt of new certifications from respective counties.

The above data should be furnished to this office at the above address. Your submission must be received by March 1, 1982, to allow its use in making distribution of the funds by the State Treasurer. Should you have any questions concerning this request, please call Mr. Bill Runnels in this office at (214) 796-2851.

Your usual prompt attention and cooperation will be appreciated.


