Commissioners Court met in Regular Session with all members present.

Judge Dean read the minutes of the February 22, 1982 meeting. Motion by J. W. Meadows seconded by Floyd Drennan for the minutes to stand as read. Motion carried.

Judge Dean read the minutes of the February 26, 1982 meeting. Motion by Charles Still seconded by J. W. Meadows for the minutes to stand as read. Motion carried.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Floyd Drennan for Sanitation Inspector, Johnny Miller, to attend the annual Texas Department of Health Convention to be held March 13 thru 17 in Galveston. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Judge Dean read a letter from Johnny Miller requesting that a well, located on property belonging to Russell Green in the Indian Rock Community, be filled in. Motion by Delmo Lawson seconded by J. W. Meadows to fill the well. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Delmo Lawson to place in the minutes a letter from Dorchester Refining Company giving the prices for Asphalt. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Two bids, which were the only two presented to the Court, were opened by Judge Dean. These bids were for a tractor for Pct. # 1. One bid from Bridges Ford Tractor, Longview totaled \$11,277.00. The other bid from Upshur County Ford Tractor, Gilmer totaled \$11,295.00. Motion was made by Delmo Lawson seconded by J. W. Meadows to turn the bids over to the County Auditor's Office for examination. Motion carried.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Floyd Drennan for the Campfire Girls to use the Courthouse Lawn March 13, 1982. Motion carried.

Motion by J. W. Meadows seconded by Floyd Drennan to sign the corrected lateral road mileage maintained by Upshur County. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Judge Dean made the motion seconded by Delmo Lawson for the Commissioners Court to continue to operate on the budget of 1981-82, which is based on the lateral road mileage. When asked to vote, Charles Still and J. W. Meadows voted not to continue. Delmo Lawson and Floyd Drennan voted to continue. At that time, Judge Dean voted in order to untie the vote. He voted to continue for the completion of the budget year.

Motion by J. W. Meadows seconded by Charles Still to continue the Upshur County Ambulance Service by dividing the service between the two companies, giving Upshur County Ambulance Service numbers 1,2,3, and 4 Commissioners Precincts and Hawkins Ambulance the Jail and the Courthouse. Motion carried.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Delmo Lawson to approve a plat of Langford Acres for recording only. Motion carried.

Mr. Morris Farrow met with the Court asking to use part of the Rock Building for the Mini-Bus garage sales. Motion by Charles Still seconded by Floyd Drennan for them to use the portion needed, with the understanding that at any time it was needed by the Court, they would give possession. Motion carried.

Mr. Wilford Parker met with the Court asking them to approve the Contract for the Probation Department. After discussion, Mr. Parker requested that the Court study the Contract and place it back on the agenda.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve payment of the ROW Deed on Hwy. 300 from Robert E. Sanders. Motion carried.

County Auditor, Keith Barber gave a report on the liability insurance on Law Enforcement and the County Court. After some discussion, motion was made by J. W. Meadows seconded by Delmo Lawson for all Constables of Upshur County to be added to the policy. Motion carried.

Motion by Floyd Drennan seconded by J. W. Meadows to approve payment of the unpaid bills, after which, personal examination was given each bill for approval, then a motion and second was made for each. Motions carried. A copy of the bills are attached.

Court adjourned at 4:00 PM .




COMMISSIONER, PCT. # 1
