March 15, 1982

Commissioners Court met in Special Session at 3:00 P.M. with all members present.

Judge Dean read the minutes of the March 8, 1982 meeting. Motion was made by Delmo Lawson seconded by J. W. Meadows for the minutes to stand as read. Motion carried.

Motion by Delmo Lawson seconded by J. W. Meadows to approve the unpaid bills. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion by J. W. Meadows seconded by Floyd Drennan for the County Auditor, Keith Barber to attend a meeting in Austin, Texas March 22 - 25. Motion carried.

Motion by Delmo Lawson seconded by J. W. Meadows to accept the lowest bid on the Ford tractor for Pct. # 1, which was \$11,277.00 from Bridges Ford Tractor, Longview. Motion carried.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Floyd Drennan for Commissioner Charles Still to be allowed to clean the brush on the ROW of Peach Road. Motion carried.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve two Permit Applications from Continental Telephone to place buried communication lines within the ROW's of Boyd Road and Aspen Trail. Motion carried. Copies attached.

Motion by J. W. Meadows seconded by Delmo Lawson to approve a Special Road Use Agreement Contract by Lang and Mitchell for use of Daffodil Road. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion by J. W. Meadows seconded by Delmo Lawson to approve two Permit Applications by Bi-County Water Supply Corp. to place water lines within the ROW's of Aster Road and Canna Road. Motion carried. Copies attached.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve a Special Road Use Agreement Contract by Luckwood Construction Company for use of Locust, White Oak and White Pine Roads. Motion carried. Copy attached.

The Commissioners Court, District Judge Virgil Mulanax, District Attorney Dwight Brannon, and Sheriff Dale Jewkes had a lengthy discussion of the Upshur County Jail. After the discussion, the Court recessed at 5:30 P.M. until 2:00 P.M. Wednesday.

The Court reopened at 2:00 P.M. Wednesday with all members present.

After touring the Upshur County Jail, the Court and Sheriff Dale Jewkes agreed to write a letter to the Jail Commissioner asking that he send a representative to make suggestions to the Court for work to be done to increase the number of jail cells of the present jail or perhaps give suggestions for remodeling of the Rock Building to be used as a County Jail.






