



UPSHUR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT
GILMER, TEXAS

June 21, 1982

Commissioners Court met in Special Session at 9:00 A.M. with all members present.

Judge Dean read the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion by J. W. Meadows seconded by Delmo Lawson for the minutes to stand as read.

Mr. Tom Brooks, developer of the Greenhills Subdivision, and a group of property owners met with the Court to discuss the road situation in their subdivision. The Greenhills addition is located in Pct. 1, just off Starling Road. Some of the property owners were under the impression that the roads had been taken into the County road system, but the Court records reflect that the Court accepted the plat of the Greenhills addition for recording purposes only. Developer Brooks and the property owners expressed a desire for help from the County to repair and maintain the roads. The Commissioners and Judge Dean agreed to take a look at the roads in the subdivision.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve an Interlocal Agreement between Upshur County and the City of Gladewater to exchange services. Motion carried. Copy attached.

The Court recessed to allow the Commissioners and Judge to tour the Greenhills Subdivision.

Court reopened at 1:35 P.M. with all members present.

After looking at the Greenhills Subdivision, the Court proposed to the developer and property owners that if they could come up with \$8,000.00, which is only a small portion of the total cost to asphalt and maintain approx. 1.9 miles, the Court would vote to take the roads into the County road system. Developer, Tom Brooks agreed to apy the \$8,000.00 and presented the Court with a check for that amount. Motion was then made by Delmo Lawson seconded by Floyd Drennan to accept Hillcrest, Highland, and Wildwood Roads into the County lateral road system. Motion carried. A plat of the subdivision and a list of the property owners who attened the Court meeting are attached. Motion by Delmo Lawson seconded by J. W. Meadows for the Court to accept the \$8,000.00 check from Brooks Land Company, Kilgore Texas to be deposited with the County Treasurer. Motion carried.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve a Permit Application by W. E. Bowen to place a ^{new} culvert within the ROW of Dead End Road. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion by Floyd Drennan seconded by Charles Still to approve a Permit Application by James Varner to place a culvert within the ROW of Arrowwood Road. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion by Floyd Drennan seconded by Charles Still to approve a Permit Application by James Varner to place a culvert within the ROW of Cherokee Trace. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion by J. W. Meadows seconded by Delmo Lawson to pay the unpaid bills. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion by J. W. Meadows seconded by Delmo Lawson to pay County employees on the 30 th of June. Motion carried.

Motion by Delmo Lawson seconded by Charles Still to adjourn. Motion carried.

SUBJECT: ANY CONTRACT BETWEEN UPSHUR COUNTY ROAD & BRIDGE DEPARTMENTS AND ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION DESIRING TO CONTRACT WITH UPSHUR COUNTY TO MUTUALLY ACCOMPLISH A PROJECT TO IMPROVE THE EFFICIENCY AND EFFECTIVENESS OF THE LOCAL POLITICAL ENTITIES INVOLVED.

AUTHORITY: ARTICLE 3 SECTION 64b OF THE TEXAS CONSTITUTION
ARTICLE 4413-32c TCS OR THE INTERLOCAL COOPERATION ACT

PROJECT OR OBJECTIVES TO BE ACCOMPLISHED:

That portion of Rodeo Street from Gay Avenue
(SPECIFIC JOB, JOBS OR ACTS)
northwest to intersection of Gay Avenue & FM 2685

Blade and set subgrade and place oil sand mix
on surface of road and compact.

PROPOSED TIME: As soon as labor and equipment, time and material
(START) are available
At earliest possible date.
(FINISH)

POLITICAL SUBDIVISION DOES PROPOSE:

To purchase and deliver \$6,000.00 in refinery
grade road oil to Upshur County Road and Bridge.

UPSHUR COUNTY DOES PROPOSE:

In exchange for 50% of yield of oil sand mix
for this project Upshur County will mix oil sand,
blade and set subgrade on said road and cover
with oil sand and compact.

This agreement made between the County of Upshur, Texas by and through the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, hereinafter called Upshur County and the City of Gladewater

by and through its City Council
hereinafter called City of Gladewater,

subject to approval of both governmental bodies within the provisions of the Open Meeting Act.

It is understood by both contracting parties that each party will pay for these services or charges with funds currently available to each party.

It is understood by both contracting parties that any civil liability or any other liability relating to the furnishing of these services is the responsibility of the party receiving the services.

It is understood that Upshur County Road and Bridge Departments can only accomplish the execution of this contract as the availability of county labor and equipment warrants. The County Commissioner acting as Road Commissioner or the designated foreman of the precinct Road and Bridge Department will have the sole responsibility as to what time is designated or allocated for execution of this contract.

It is further understood by all contracting parties this contract or agreement can only be final after examination by the attorney or legal advisors of both parties and the signature of the County or District Attorney is hereby affixed.

It is further agreed and understood between the parties herein that this Interlocal Governmental Agreement shall be for a period of one year from date of execution.
