



- Payments for such oil shall be made on or before the 25th day of the month succeeding such purchases. Payments may be made to the owners shown above in person or by mailing your check therefor to the address of the owners designated to receive same as shown above. Provided however, that at your option no payments shall be made to an owner until the sum due on account of such interest shall amount to \$5.00 or more.
- Quantities shall be computed from regularly compiled tank tables or by other reliable methods of computation (the owners to have the privilege of witnessing the gauge ticks) and correction shall be made for temperature and impurities according to the prevailing practice and the rules and regulations prescribed by the Commission or other legal authority of the State where the purchases hereunder are made.
