



UPSHUR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT

September 28, 1982 |

Commissioners Court met in Special Session at 9:30 A.M. for the 1982-1983 fiscal year Budget Hearing. All members of the Court were present.

Judge Dean opened the meeting by going over some of the things in the budget that were different from last years budget. He explained that all employees were given a 10% cost of living raise and some as much as 14%. He then asked for any discussion there might be on the budget.

Frank Breazeale, Jack Taylor, Tom Brymer, and Malcolm Smith met with the Court asking the Court to reconsider buying a grass fire truck, which is badly needed by the City to fight rural grass fires. Judge Dean stated that the County had set aside money in the budget that could be used for a fire truck, but they had not designated it for that purpose as yet. He said that the Court is still considering the truck, but is looking at all the options. Mr. Breazeale thanked the Court for their consideration. No action was taken at this time.

Johnny Miller, representing the Health Department met with the Court and presented a list of items that he thought may not have been considered when the budget was prepared. He also expressed the need for the Health Dept. to keep a petty cash fund. No action was taken at this time.

Dwight Brannon met with the Court concerning the budget. He felt that his office will be exceeding the amount allowed under Services & Charges for the 1982-1983 fiscal year.

Commissioner Delmo Lawson asked a question concerning the amount of raise given to one of his crew. County Auditor, Keith Barber, gave an explanation of how he arrived at the amount.

Motion was then made by J. W. Meadows seconded by Charles Still to adopt the proposed budget for the fiscal year 1982-1983. Motion carried.

Court closed the Budget Hearing at approx. 10:40 A.M.

Court reopened at 11:00 A.M.

Judge Dean read the minutes of the September 23 meeting. Motion was made by J. W. Meadows seconded by Delmo Lawson for the minutes to stand as read. Motion carried.

Orvil Lindsey met with the Court asking the Court to take some action on rerouting a portion of Pecan Road. No action was taken at this time.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Delmo Lawson to allow Dr. J. L. Fenlaw, Jerry Waters, Johnny W. Miller, and Alva Cleo Snow to attend the East Texas Regional TPHA meeting in Longview, October 7 & 8. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion by Delmo Lawson seconded by J. W. Meadows to allow an abandoned well on property belonging to Dr. Oneta Henson to be filled in because it poses a health hazard. Motion carried. Copy attached.



PROJECT OR OBJECTIVES TO BE ACCOMPLISHED:

To cover bus parking area with oil dirt and

PROPOSED TIME: Will repair as manpower and material become
(START) available.

(FINISH)

POLITICAL SUBDIVISION DOES PROPOSE:

To furnish sand and road oil to cover bus
parking area and driveways for school and
to furnish Upshur County an equal amount of
sand and road oil.

UPSHUR COUNTY DOES PROPOSE:

To furnish manpower and equipment to cover
bus parking area and driveways of the New
Diana Independent School District.

This agreement made between the County of Upshur, Texas by and through the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, hereinafter called Upshur County and the New Diana Independent School District by and through its Board of Trustees hereinafter called New Diana Independent School District subject to approval of both governmental bodies within the provisions of the Open Meeting Act.

It is understood by both contracting parties that each party will pay for these services or charges with funds currently available to each party.

It is understood by both contracting parties that any civil liability or any other liability relating to the furnishing of these services is the responsibility of the party receiving the services.

It is understood that Upshur County Road and Bridge Departments can only accomplish the execution of this contract as the availability of county labor and equipment warrants. The County Commissioner acting as Road Commissioner or the designated foreman of the precinct Road and Bridge Department will have the sole responsibility as to what time is designated or allocated for execution of this contract.

It is further understood by all contracting parties this contract or agreement can only be final after examination by the attorney or legal advisors of both parties and the signature of the County or District Attorney is hereby affixed.

It is further agreed and understood between the parties herein that this Interlocal Governmental Agreement shall be for a period of one year from date of execution.
