Judge Dean read the minutes of the Oct. 22, 1982 meeting. Motion was made by Floyd Drennan seconded by Charles Still for the minutes to stand as read. Motion carried.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve the payment on two ROW deeds for Hwy. 300 from the following people. Motion carried.
 Robert J. Glendinning and wife, Jessie Opal Glendinning
 Jesse Opal Glendinning and husband, Robert J. Glendinning.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve a Permit Application by David Shoup to place a culvert within the ROW of Lemon Road. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion by Floyd Drennan seconded by J. W. Meadows to approve a Permit Application by Etex Telephone Coop. to place a buried telephone cable within the ROW of Machen Lane. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion by J. W. Meadows seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve a Permit Application by Jesse Loffer to place a culvert within the ROW of Turkey Road. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Floyd Drennan to approve a Permit Application by Exxon Company, U.S.A. to construct two pipeline crossings beneath Silk Tree and Fir Roads. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Ten bids were received by the Court on various office equipment. Judge Dean opened each bid. Motion was made by J. W. Meadows seconded by Floyd Drennan to turn the bids over to the County Auditor for inspection. Action will be taken on the bids Monday, Nov. 15, 1982. Motion carried.

Mr. Parker introduced Elmer Mitchell, with Business Computing System, Huntsville, Texas, who spoke to the Court concerning a computer system. No action was taken at this time.

Court recessed until 1:30 P.M.
 Court reopened at 1:30 P.M.

Motion was made by Floyd Drennan seconded by Charles Still to canvass the votes of the Nov. 2, 1982 election. Motion carried. The votes were canvassed by the Court and approved.

Judge Dean opened two bids, which were the only bids received for gasoline for the road and bridge department. One bid was from Young Oil Company, the other from Mitchell Oil Company. Motion was made by J. W. Meadows seconded by Charles Still to turn the bids over to the auditor until Monday, Nov. 15, 1982 at which time some action will be taken. Motion carried.

Judge Dean opened two bids on two cars for the Sheriff's Department. The bids were from Yazell Chevrolet Olds and Long Motor Company. These were the only bids received. Motion by Charles Still seconded by J. W. Meadows to turn the bids over to the County Auditor until Monday, Nov. 15, 1982.

Motion by J. W. Meadows seconded by Floyd Drennan to pay the election workers. Motion carried.

Court recessed until Tuesday morning.


Court reopened at 9:00 A.M. Tuesday morning.

The _____ County Commissioners' Court offers no objection to the location of the right of way of your proposed _____ line as shown by accompanying drawing and notice dated _____ except as noted below.

It is expressly understood that the _____ County Commissioners' Court does not purpose here to grant any right, claim, title, or easement in or upon this county road; it is further understood that in the future should for any reason _____ County need to work, improve locate, widen, increase, add to, or in any manner change the structure of this right of way this line, if effected, will be moved under the direction of the _____ County and shall be relocated at the complete expense of the owner.

All work on the county right of way shall be performed in accordance with the County Engineer's instructions. The installation shall not damage any part of the highway and adequate provision must be made to cause minimum inconvenience to traffic and adjacent owners. Specifications for placing this line are as follows:

1. All ground lines are to be installed a minimum of 36 inches below the flow line of the adjacent drainage or barrow ditch, when crossing or placed in said ditch.
2. All excavations within the right of way and not under surfacing shall be backfilled by tamping in 6 inch horizontal layers. All surplus material shall be removed from the right of way and the excavation finished flush with surrounding natural ground.
3. Lines crossing under surfaced roads and under surfaced cross roads within the right of way shall be placed by boring. Boring shall extend from crown line to crown line. Gravity flow sewer lines under roadways shall be cast iron pipe.
4. All lines under roads carrying pressure in excess of 50 psi shall be enclosed in satisfactory casing extending from right of way line to right of way line. Pipe used for casing may be of any type approved by the County Engineer and shall be capable of supporting load of roadbed and traffic and shall be so constructed that there will be no leakage of matter through the casing for its entire length. Inside diameter of casing shall be at least 2 inches greater than the largest diameter of carrier pipe, joints or couplings.
5. All lines, where practicable, shall be located to cross roadbed at approximately right angles thereto. No lines are to be installed under or within 50 feet of either end of any bridge. No lines shall be placed in any culvert or within 10 feet of the closest point of same.
6. Parallel lines will be installed as near the right of way lines as is possible and no parallel line will be installed in the roadbed or between the drainage ditch and the roadbed without special permission of the County Engineer.
7. Overhead lines will have a minimum clearance of 18 feet above the road surface at the point of crossing.
8. Operations along roadways shall be performed in such a manner that all excavated materials be kept off the pavements at all times, as well as all operating equipment and materials. No equipment or installation procedures will be used which will damage any road surface or structures. The cost of any repairs to road surface, roadbed, structures or other right of way features as a direct result of this installation will be borne by the owner of this line.
9. Barricades, warning signs and lights, and flagmen when necessary shall be provided by the contractor or owner. One half of the traveled portion of the road must be open at all times.

On this, the _____ day of _____, 1982, on Motion duly made, seconded and passed by the Commissioners' Court of Upshur County, Texas, and entered in its Minutes, the foregoing Petition is hereby granted, and said applicant is hereby granted (so far as the County is able to grant) permission, right and privilege to lay, maintain, repair and operate two (2) pipeline road crossings under and across the certain roads and ditches as shown on the map attached to said application upon the conditions, and agreement of Petitioner, that said pipelines are to be laid, operated, repaired, and maintained so as not to interfere with the drainage, proper maintenance, and free and undisturbed use of said roads, and to relocate or change at Petitioner's risk and expense said pipelines within the existing right of way limits as directed by the County Engineer or Commissioners' Court upon reasonable notice, and to save the County, and each of its Commissioners harmless from any cause of action aforesaid. It is expressly understood that the Upshur County Commissioners' Court does not purport, hereby, to grant any right, claim, title or easement in or upon this county road; it is further understood that in the future should for any reason Upshur County need to work, improve, relocate, widen, increase, add to, or in any manner change the structure of this right of way, this appurtenance, if affected, will be moved under the direction of the Upshur County Commissioners' Court representative and shall be relocated at the complete expense of the owner within thirty (30) days upon receipt of notice from the Commissioners' Court.

All work on the county right of way shall be performed in accordance with the Commissioners' Court's instructions. The installation shall not damage any part of the highway and adequate provisions must be made to cause minimum inconvenience to traffic and adjacent owners. Special specifications for placing this line are as follows:

1. Barricades, warning signs and lights, and flagmen when necessary shall be provided by the contractor or owner. One-half of the traveled portion of the road must be open at all times.
2. All lines, where practicable, shall be located to cross roadbed at approximately right angles thereto. No lines are to be installed under or within 50 feet of either end of any bridge. No lines shall be placed in any culvert or within 10 feet of the closest point of same.
3. Parallel lines will be installed as near the right of way lines as is possible and no parallel line will be installed in the roadbed or between the drainage ditch and the roadbed without special permission of the County Commissioners' Court.
4. Overhead lines will have a minimum clearance of 18 feet above the road surface at the point of crossing.
5. Operations along roadways shall be performed in such a manner that all excavated material be kept off the surface at all times, as well as all operating equipment and materials. No equipment, or installation procedures will be used which will damage any road surface or structures. The cost of any repairs to road surface, roadbed, structures or other right of way features as a direct result of this installation will be borne by the owner of this line.
6. All lines under roads carrying pressure in excess of 50 psi shall be enclosed in satisfactory casing extending from the right of way line to right of way

line. Pipe used for casing may be of any type approved by the County Engineer or Commissioners' Court and shall be capable of supporting load of roadbed and traffic and shall be so constructed that there will be no leakage of any matter through casing for its entire length. Inside diameter of casing shall be at least 2 inches greater than the largest diameter of carrier pipe, joints, or couplings.

- 7. All excavations within the right of way and not under surfacing shall be backfilled by tamping in 6-inch horizontal layers. All surplus material shall be removed from the right of way and the excavation finished flush with surrounding natural ground.
- 8. All ground lines are to be installed a minimum of 36 inches below the flow line of the adjacent drainage or borrow ditch.

Any material placed in county right of way by permit will be of a nature or composition that said line can be located with the use of a standard locator device used in locating buried cables or pipes.

- 9. Lines crossing under roads and under cross-roads within the right of way shall be placed by boring. Boring shall extend from crown line to crown line. Gravity flow sewer lines under roadways shall be cast iron or equivalent pipe.
- 10. Where evidence is presented indicating the impracticability of boring or tunnelling, the Commissioners' Court may grant permission to cut the surfacing no wider than 4 inches. In the event a cut is permitted the following conditions will govern;
 - (a) Excavation areas are to be filled and packed with compatible material; and
 - (b) The surfacing will be replaced with equivalent quality surfacing.
- 11. Notice will be given to the precinct Commissioner 48 hours prior to starting construction of the line in that Commissioners' precinct.
- 12. Where in the opinion of the Upshur County Commissioners' Court it may be considered necessary to protect losses incurred by damages to the roads, bridges, on right of way structures, they may by action of the Court require a surety bond in the amount sufficient to cover any damages.
- 13. Where, in the opinion of the Commissioners' Court, an inspector is necessary, the party receiving permit will bear the cost of an inspector.
