




RE: Abandoned well located on Property belonging to Mrs. Ewell Blackstone

R E S O L U T I O N

The Commissioners Court of Upshur County meeting, legally assembled in special session on February 21, 1983 did pass the following resolution:

WHEREAS Upshur County maintains approximateley 585 miles of road in its county lateral road system and;

WHEREAS the unlawful dumping of solid waste on these roads has presented a very expensive maintenance problem, has created a very unhealthy environmental situation and a grossly unsightly spectacle for our Upshur County citizens to view, drive through and tolerate.

WHEREAS the act of unlawfully disposing of trash, junk, garbage, refuse, unsightly matter or any other solid waste on public highways right of way or on any public or private property or into any public waterway is a misdemeanor and any violator upon conviction of the violation of such act will be fined not less than \$15.00 nor more than \$200.00.

THEREFORE the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas in order to assist the various communities and the Upshur County Road & Bridge Departments in alleviating this per-sistanting problem does hereby authorize Upshur County to pay the sum of \$100.00 reward for information leading to the conviction of any violations of Article 4477-9 (unlawful dumping or disposal of solid waste).

The undersigned, Haughton Timber Co., hereinafter referred to as First Party, enters into and makes an agreement with Upshur County Commissioner of Precinct No. 3, Upshur County, Texas, and in order to get material to market it is necessary to use a portion of Upshur County roads located in Precinct No. 3, over which Commissioner has jurisdiction and obligation to maintain in good repair and both parties being aware of possible damage to said roads as a result of hauling on and over same enter into the following agreement.

1.

First Party agrees to use only that section of (describe road) Red Maple Road  
Going off Highway 1795 - go out on Highway 1002

2.

First Party agrees to use its vehicles in such a manner as not to block or interfere with other traffic on said road so that said road will be open to travel by the public at all times.

First Party agrees to grade, maintain and otherwise repair said road using its own equipment, labor and materials, if any needed, during the duration of time that First Party is removing logs from its lands located in Precinct No. 3, Upshur County.

First Party agrees to put said road back into the same condition as it was prior to the commencement of hauling operations on the part of First Party.
