March 14, 1983

Commissioners Court met in Regular Session with all members present.

Judge Dean read the minutes of the March 7, 1983 meeting. Motion was made by Charles Still seconded by Paul Davis to approve the minutes as read. Motion carried.

City Manager, Tom Brymer and Mayor Malcolm Smith met with the Court concerning the City's request for the County to purchase a grass fire truck for the City. After some discussion, motion was made by J. W. Meadows seconded by Delmo Lawson for the County to give the City some decision at the next Court meeting.

Two bids were received on the County depository. One bid was from Gladewater National Bank, Gladewater, and the other from the First National Bank, Gilmer. The bids were opened by Judge Dean, then turned over to the County Auditor for examination. Motion was made by J. W. Meadows seconded by Delmo Lawson to take action on the bids at the next Court meeting. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Paul Davis seconded by Charles Still to authorize the County Treasurer to destroy old bonds and checks, with the understanding that a list of what is to be destroyed is made with a copy of the law authorizing these items to be destroyed attached. Motion carried.

Judge Dean read a letter to the Court from the Texas Association of Counties' concerning the Law Suit filed against the Jail Standards Commission asking Upshur County to join in the suit and donate funds for the suit. No action was taken at this time.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Delmo Lawson to approve the filling in of an abandoned well located on property belonging to Joe Loyd. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Delmo Lawson to re-nominate Linzy Bowie to serve on the Board of Directors of the Jobs, Training and Services, Inc. for this calender year. Motion carried. Copy attached.



Motion by J. W. Meadows seconded by Delmo Lawson to approve payment of the unpaid bills. Motion carried. Copy attached.


County Auditor, Keith Barber gave a comparison of the two depository bids. No action was taken at this time.

Provide inmates with one (1) hour of supervised physical exercise/recreation a minimum of three (3) days per week.

This agreement entered into this _____ day of _____, 19____, by and between the State of Texas, acting by and through the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation, hereinafter called the State, and Upshur County, Texas, acting by and through its duly authorized official under Commissioners' Court Order dated 14th day of October, 1968, hereinafter called the County, and Glenwood Water Supply Corp. acting by and through its duly authorized representative, hereinafter called the Owner.

WHEREAS, the State and County have previous to this date entered into a contract agreeing to handle by separate contract the adjustment, removal or relocation of certain utility facilities necessitated as a result of highway improvements on the subject project on the basis of a predetermined firm commitment for right of way reimbursement approved by the State;

WHEREAS, the Owner, in an affidavit dated December 23, 1982, has asserted an interest in certain lands and that this proposed highway improvement will necessitate the adjustment, removal or relocation of certain facilities of the Owner now located upon such lands as indicated in the following statement of work: Rearrange and/or relocate waterlines along St. 300 and Grouse Road area, along FM 726 and proposed St. 300, along St. 300 at Penguin Road and to the South.

WHEREAS, the State and the County desire to accomplish the adjustment, removal or relocation of the Owner's utility facilities by entering into an agreement with the Owner;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it mutually agreed that this contract entered into this date between the parties hereto is intended to implement and effectuate the terms and provisions of that contract of February 13, 1978, entered into between the State and the County, as it pertains to right of way utility adjustments and as it effects the utility facilities of the Owner.

Upon execution of this agreement by the parties hereto the County will, by written notice, authorize the Owner to proceed with the necessary adjustment, removal or relocation; and the Owner agrees to prosecute such work diligently to completion in such manner as will not result in avoidable interference or delay in either the State's highway construction or in the said work.

The Owner will carry out said adjustments, removals or relocations in accordance with the plans attached hereto, and the costs paid by the County pursuant to this contract shall be full compensation to the Owner for the costs incurred in making such adjustments, removals or relocations. Bills for work hereunder shall be submitted to the County not later than ninety (90) days after completion of the work.

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and Public Transportation
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The County, subject to the acquisition of such rights or interests as may be deemed necessary along or across the Owner's interest in land, agrees to pay the Owner and the Owner agrees to accept a lump sum amount of \$ 16,293.12 as full reimbursement for work covered by this contract, said reimbursement to be forthcoming in such lump sum only after receipt of a lump sum final billing in the foregoing amount accompanied by a certificate to the effect that such work has been fully accomplished. The State will reimburse the County in an amount equal to 90 per cent of the lump sum payment to the Owner upon receipt of proper billing and certificate by the County that payment in this amount has been made to the Owner

It is expressly understood that this contract is subject to cancellation by either the State or the County at any time up to the date that work under this contract has been authorized and that such cancellation will not create any liability on either the part of the State or the County.


